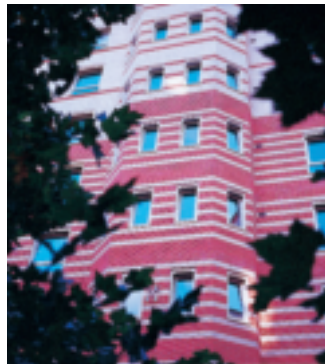
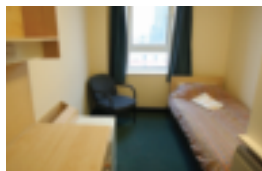

















Welcome to Stamford Street Apartments



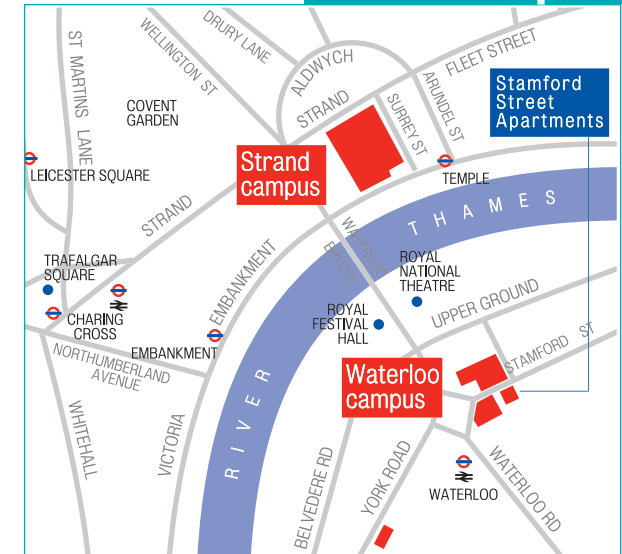

Located in the heart of Waterloo, within minutes of Waterloo International Station, Stamford Street Apartments is a modern purpose built residence with 537 ensuite bedrooms arranged apartment style. All apartments share a communal kitchen/diner, suitable for preparing light snacks and drinks, but guests must supply their own crockery cutlery & utensils. All bedrooms are equipped with a small fridge.



Facilities

-  number of single ensuite rooms: 537 (small fridge in every room)
-  ensuite facilities; complimentary toiletries provided on arrival
-  complimentary tea & coffee pack provided on arrival
-  housekeeping – general servicing Monday-Friday, linen change: once a week, towel change: twice a week, bathroom and bedroom cleaned daily
-  television in kitchen diner, telephone in reception, access to K4 Gym available to summer guests at low cost fee.
-  self-catering of light snacks allowed in kitchens, but must provide own crockery, cutlery and utensils
-  dining facilities (nearby campus) – breakfast, lunch and dinner for groups only on request
-  check-in 2pm; check-out 10am
-  payment in full upon arrival (except long stay and groups); credit cards accepted
-  24 hr security
-  laundry facilities available at additional cost
-  nearest 24 hr car park: Cornwall Road or South Bank Arts complex
-  house policy – a child aged between 8 and 18 years of age may be accepted but must be accompanied by a designated responsible adult, such as a parent, guardian or teacher
-  disabled access available, limited availability of bedrooms fitted with facilities for disabled
-  smoking is not permitted in any King's College London residence or building. Guests who wish to do so may smoke in designated external areas only.

 Waterloo/Waterloo East. Mainline suburban rail services to the south east/west and Eurostar services to France and Belgium

Directions From Waterloo Station take the exit for the IMAX cinema, from there follow the signposts for King's College London and Stamford Street. Walk up Stamford Street and the Apartments are on your right hand side. The Waterloo area is served by a large number of buses including bus numbers 4, 243, 168, 77, 176, 188 and the RV1. Night buses also operate throughout the night in the Waterloo area.
