Two of our Residences; Stamford Street Apartments (Waterloo) and Great Dover Street Apartments (London Bridge), were recently awarded a 3-star Campus Rating from Visit Britain and provide modern ensuite accommodation near the vibrant South Bank and London Bridge; whilst our more traditional residences at Hampstead and Denmark Hill (zone 2) are ideally suited to those looking to escape the hustle and bustle of the city; both set in leafy suburbs offering standard traditional accommodation on a bed & breakfast basis but very easily accessible from Central London.

Our flexible options mean that you can book from as little as one person for one night or a large group booking for several weeks. Our rates are very competitive and we offer discounts for long stays, young persons (U26), seniors (60+) and for groups of 10 or more.



## Our residences – useful information

### Locations

- King's College London Residences are situated in some great locations at: Waterloo – Stamford Street Apartments (zone 1), London Bridge – Great Dover Street Apartments (zone 1), Hampstead – Hampstead Residence (zone 2), Denmark Hill – King's College Hall (zone 2).

### General information

- Check In is from 14.00 (2 pm) and Check Out before 10.00 (10 am).
- All Residences have 24-hour security.
- There are no curfews at the Residences but all guests are requested to respect the quiet hours between 23.00 and 08.00.
- Bed linen and towels are provided for all guests.
- Bedrooms cleaned/serviced on a regular basis.
- All King's College London premises are non-smoking (some have designated smoking shelters).

### Facilities & services

- Laundry facilities are available at all Residences (at additional costs).
- Vending machines are available at all Residences for the sale of snacks and soft drinks.
- TVs provided for guest use at all Residences (located in either communal kitchens or common rooms).
- At Stamford Street and Great Dover Street Apartments self-catering for individuals is permitted, but guests must provide their own crockery, cutlery and utensils as these are not supplied.
- Stamford Street & Great Dover Street Apartments are sold on a room-only basis whilst Hampstead Residence

and King's College Hall are sold on a bed & breakfast basis.

- Mini-fridges located in rooms at Stamford Street and Great Dover Street Apartments for guest use.
- Half and full board catering options are available to groups at all sites.
- Limited car/coach parking available only at King's College Hall (upon request).
- At present King's College London is unable to offer internet access to guests.

All enquiries and reservations are handled centrally by Conference & Timetabling Services. Our team of professional staff can advise you on best location, suitability and availability.

- **Age restrictions** – Reservations can only be made by those over the age of 18. We regret that we cannot accept reservations for individual guests aged under 18. Children under the age of 18 may be accepted at our Residences but must be accompanied by a designated responsible adult (such as parent, guardian or teacher).
- **Availability** – As a busy working university, our accommodation is available to guests during the summer, usually from late June to mid September each year.
- **Numbers** – We can take reservations from one person upwards to groups of all sizes subject to availability
- **No minimum stay** – We don't impose a minimum number of nights, at any time we are open to the public, so you can stay for as little or as long as you like (availability permitting).
- **Cost** – We realise that London can be expensive and therefore offer a range of cost effective, value for money rates across our Residences. We also offer

discounts for long stays, Young Persons (18-26), Seniors (60+) as well as group rates (for groups of 10+).

- **Deposits & balance of payment** – A deposit is required in all cases to secure a reservation (this is non-refundable in cases of cancellation and/or non-arrival).
  - For *independent traveller reservations* (nine people or less) full payment will be required at the time of booking (unless otherwise agreed with Conference & Timetabling Services). Where any outstanding amount is due, the balance is payable upon check in.
  - For *group reservations* a specified deposit amount (usually 50 per cent of reservation value at time of booking) will be required at the time of booking. The balance of payment is invoiced after your stay.
- **Confirmation of your reservation** – A copy of your reservation will be sent to you (usually by email) in advance of your stay and will include your unique reference number, reservation details, deposits paid and outstanding balance. If you have any questions about your reservation then please contact us straight away. Please quote your reference number when contacting us and when checking in.
- **Payment methods** – When making reservations, payment can be made by credit/debit card (Visa/Mastercard/Maestro), cheque (sterling only and drawn on a British bank), cash or travellers cheques. BACS is also accepted for group payments. American Express and Diners cards are not accepted.
