




our residences – useful information

- All residences have 24 hour security
- Check in is from 2pm and check out prior to 10am
- Bed linen and towels are provided for all guests
- Bedrooms cleaned/serviced on a regular basis
- All residences are easily accessible by public transport (for more information visit our website at www.kcl.ac.uk/kcvb)
- Laundry facilities are available at all residences (at additional cost)
- Bookings can only be made by those over the age of 18
- Children under the age of 18 may be accepted at our residences but must be accompanied by a designated responsible adult (such as a parent, guardian or teacher)
- All King's College London premises are non smoking. Some have designated smoking shelters within the grounds
- At Stamford Street & Great Dover Street Apartments, self-catering for individuals is permitted, but guests must provide their own crockery, cutlery and utensils
- Half and full board catering options are available to groups at all sites
- At present King's College London is unable to offer internet access to guests
- Coach parking only available at King's College Hall (on request)
- TVs are provided for guest use at all residences (located in either communal kitchens or common rooms)
- There are no curfews at the College Residences, but all guests are requested to respect the quiet hours between 23:00 and 08:00

how to book your accommodation for your next visit to London

- **Availability** – as a busy working university our accommodation is available during the summer from late June to mid September each year
- **Locations** – we have 4 locations offering both ensuite & traditional rooms. See our website for location details and maps
- **Numbers** – you can book from as little as one person for one night or a large group booking for several weeks subject to availability
- **Our team** – we have a dedicated team of professionals available to discuss the best fit for your booking – contact us and we will be happy to help
- **Cost** – our rates vary depending on which location you wish to stay at but range from £20 - £40 per night. Young persons (18-26), Senior (60+) and Group rates (for groups of 10+) also available
- **Online** – you can book accommodation for up to 9 people by using our online booking service – see our website for details
- **Deposit** – for independent travellers a non-refundable deposit is payable at the time of booking, with the balance payable upon check-in. For groups a specified deposit amount will be required to secure your booking and the balance invoiced after your stay
- **Terms & Conditions** – all bookings are subject to our Terms and Conditions which are available on our website
- **Payments** – payment can be made by credit/debit card, cheque (sterling only), cash or BACS (for groups only). American Express, and Diners cards are not accepted.
