

Where are my classes being held?

In order to fit information onto the timetable there is a system of abbreviations used to indicate the various rooms and campuses at which teaching takes place.

FFLB02 and FFLB03	School of Law seminar rooms in the basement of the Law building on the Strand campus
FFL[then 3 numbers]	staff office in the School of Law building on the Strand campus
FFL14SEB	tutorial room in the South East Block near the junction between the Students Union building and the South Range of the King's Building on the Strand campus
STD	Strand campus
STD/S	Strand Building, Strand Campus STD/S-1.XX First basement STD/S-2.XX Second basement STD/S-3.XX Third basement STD/S1.XX First floor etc
STD/GFSB[then 1 number]	Strand Building, ground floor, Strand campus
STD/342N	Norfolk Building, Strand campus
STD/2A	Chesham Building, Strand campus
STD/E1	North Wing, Strand campus
STD/C16	North Wing, Strand campus
STD/Q135	Access via the basement of the King's Building, Strand campus
STD/K	King's Building (the old, posh building), Strand campus STD/K-1.XX First basement STD/K1.XX First floor etc
WAT	Waterloo campus
WAT/F-WB	Franklin Wilkins Building, Waterloo campus
WAT/JCMB	James Clerk Maxwell Building, Waterloo campus
WAT/WBW	Waterloo Bridge Wing [sometimes called 'the annex' by people who have worked at King's for a few years] of the Franklin Wilkins Building, Waterloo campus
WAT/SS1	Stamford Street Lecture Theatre, Stamford Street Apartments, Waterloo campus

Some classes are co-taught with other Colleges and may be offered either in rooms at those Colleges or at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies. The abbreviations for these locations are as follows:
