

#### Day Centre Services


- > 10 day centres within Community Care
- ➤ 429 service user places per day
- Staff group of approximately 200 staff
- Regulated services
  - RQIA
  - Minimum Standards for Day Care
  - Monitoring Schedule
  - Annual Inspection




