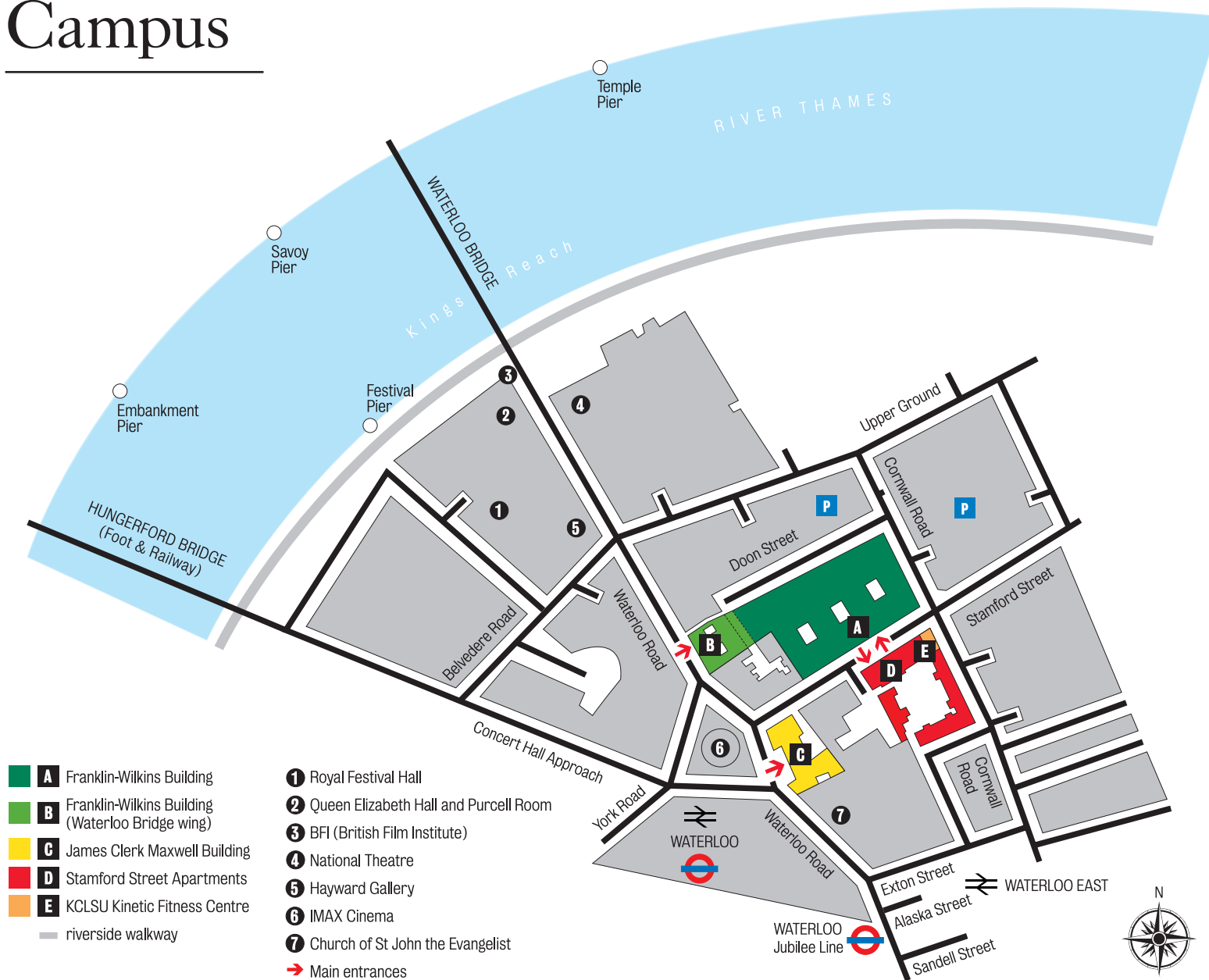

## Travelling to the Waterloo Campus

### By underground

WATERLOO (Bakerloo, Jubilee, Northern & Waterloo & City lines): 5 minute walk

By rail (overground): WATERLOO EAST and WATERLOO MAIN LINE stations: 5 minute walk

### By bus

Buses stopping at Waterloo Bus Station: (24 hour service), Buses stopping outside Franklin-Wilkins Building (Stamford St): 381 (24 hour service), 343 (24hr service)

### By boat (commuter river service)

From the west ( Putney) and from the east (Woolwich Arsenal): disembark at Festival Pier: 5 minute walk

### Parking

A pay and display parking system operates in nearby streets eg Cornwall Road, Doon Street  
Motorcycles: Bays available in Cornwall Rd.

### Bicycle

There are bicycle stands outside the front entrances of Franklin-Wilkins and James Clerk Maxwell buildings
