It is useful to prepare your list of modules in advance (with module code, name, credit value, semester and timetable information) as the form must be completed in one attempt - you cannot save and return to it later.

Please make sure you consider your choices carefully and **only** include modules that you would be happy to take. As spaces are limited, you may be registered to modules that are lower down in your order of preference.

If you submit this form more than once before we have processed the first one (i.e. given you a module allocation), only your most recently submitted form will be considered - any earlier submissions will be automatically deleted by the system - and you will now be further back in the queue.

Module amendments, for ANY reason except Underloading, will only be possible once we open the amendment period. We will let you know when it does open, so please do not attempt to make amendments before then. Amendments to resolve timetable clashes will be prioritised.

It may take us up to around 6 weeks to process your MRF, please be patient waiting for a response and do not email for updates on your registration as this will only add delays to processing.

You must meet the eligibility criteria for any module requested, so for example please do not request postgraduate modules (level 7) if you are an undergraduate (or vice-versa).

If you request modules at level 6, you must have taken AT LEAST 6 related modules at your home university from the same department/subject area, in addition to meeting any specific pre-requirements mentioned in the module description in the module catalogue(s). You should only realistically be requesting level 6 modules in a subject that is your major.

Make sure it is clear they are yours (with your name on the document). This also includes transcripts for other universities you attended (e.g. you transferred or did a summer course) if not provided in your application.

You can also email us that way module outlines if it is not clear on your transcripts that a module you took meets a pre-requisite for a module you are requesting.

Please email your new transcript promptly after submitting your MRF. If we cannot find your new transcript when processing your MRF, we will proceed without it. The email will automatically be filed away and not looked at until we process your MRF, so please send any questions separately from the email with your transcript.
