

In-year amendments to the academic regulations 2022/23 for pre-undergraduate courses

Reassessment for students on pre-undergraduate courses

- KF1 Students will be offered one reassessment opportunity in failed core modules.
- KF2 Students will not normally be offered a reassessment opportunity in non-core modules they have failed if:
 - a. they have achieved a mark in the condonable range, and they have not reached the overall condonable credit volume permitted; or
 - b. they have achieved a mark in the condonable range and have met the requirements for their registered award.

Condonement at level 3

KF3 For non-core modules at level 3, condonement will normally be granted after the first attempt, where students have achieved a mark in the range of 1-39 inclusive.
