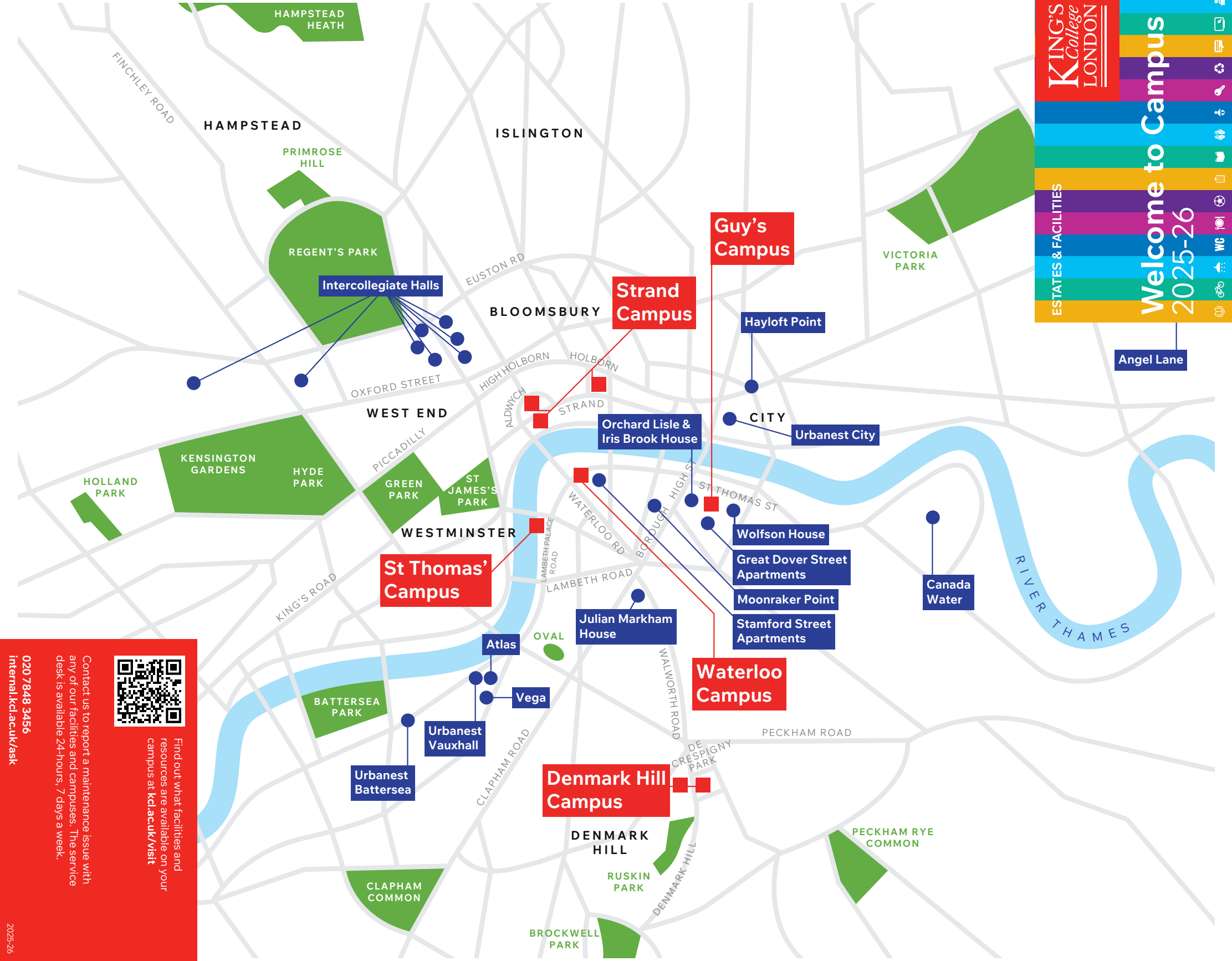

Cycling to campus



A mixture of public and secure cycle parking is available across our campuses, sports grounds and residences. Cycling to and between campuses is one of the ways that our community supports sustainable travel and helps to reduce carbon emissions.
