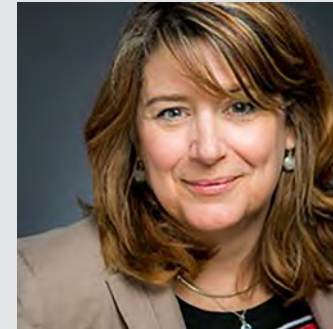
A welcome note from Jo Fowler, Director of Professional Education

Case study: GenAI Expert Training Programme

Recent findings from LexisNexis revealed that 40% of lawyers extensively use artificial intelligence (AI) in their work. Linklaters' GenAI Expert Training programme, designed in collaboration with The Dickson Poon School of Law, was designed to boost expertise of its lawyers in this area.

Participants spent one weekend exploring the technical basics of machine learning, generative AI architecture and large language model usage in legal practice. The weekend ended with a hackathon, with groups pitching in front of a judging panel of representatives from both Linklaters and King's.

Case study: Developing a module for King's Health Partners

The King's Professional Education team have helped create a new obstetrics course for KHP Women & Children's Health. This is part of a wider KHP project to develop programmes that strengthen the workforce.

The module encompasses medical disorders in pregnancy and helps advance knowledge of obstetric medicine in a multidisciplinary setting. It is delivered in a hybrid mode so professionals can join from wherever they are in the world.

The first cohort included a range of professionals – midwives, an obstetric nephrologist, a sonographer, a physio and a pharmacist.
