DEMANDING EQUITABLE TREATMENT FOR GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANTS

- FACT: More than 50% of teaching at King's College London is carried out by casual staff.
- FACT: 96% of King's College London GTAs perform much of their work for free.
- FACT: King's exploits casual teachers in order to cover oversubscribed courses.
- FACT: King's has openly described GTAs as 'apprentices,' which insults our essential work.
- FACT: Our two-year teaching qualification (PGCAPHE) has been scrapped by the college.
- FACT: In real terms, many GTAs work for less than minimum wage. Our Principal Ed Byrne earns £452,000 per year. How much work does he do for the college?

HERE ARE SOME OF THE PROPOSALS OF OUR CAMPAIGN:

1. Essay-based marking should be paid at a rate of 2000 words per hour (as is the case at Essex and Glasgow).

2. All payment and HR processes should be carried out in-house; the use of Direct Temping or other agencies should be discontinued immediately.

- 3. Preparation should be paid at a ratio of 4:1 to teaching.
- 4. Sufficient training should be provided for GTAs and it should be paid for by the college.
