Who are we?

We are the members of the Centre for Human and Applied Physiological Sciences, part of King's College London. If you need to contact us about this privacy notice, please write to irene.di_giulio@kcl.ac.uk.

Why do we process your personal information?

We process your personal information in order to:

1. *Invite you to get involved in the project (for example attending an event, or a focus group etc);*
2. *Invite you to take part in research associated with the project (for example as a research participants);*
3. *Send you further information and updates from the project.*

What is our 'legal basis for processing'?

Data protection legislation allows us to use your personal information in this way because it is required for our public purpose as a teaching and research institution and you have actively given us your permission (or 'consent'). In our assessment, the impacts on you do not override the benefits of the processing.

You may withdraw your consent at any time by emailing irene.di_giulio@kcl.ac.uk and requesting your contacts to be removed from our database.

Do you have to provide your personal information and what are the consequences of not doing so?

You must provide the personal information requested to be contacted by the research team (only your email address is required, the other information is optional). If you do not provide the information, we will not be able to include in further communication regarding the project.

How long do we keep your information for?

We will keep your information for three years in order to be able to contact you for the duration of the project and any follow-ups.

Do we share your information with other organisations?

We will not share your information with any external organisations. On rare occasions, we may be required or permitted to share personal information by law (e.g for law enforcement purposes).

What are your rights and who can you contact if you have a concern?

Will your personal information be transferred overseas?

Your personal information may be transferred to other countries within the European Economic Area (such as Germany, the Netherlands and Italy), as they host the sites of the European Space Agency and our partners. As these countries are within the European Economic Area, the data protection rules and standards are the same as in the UK.
