Environmental Leadership for Climate Resilience: CEO Environmental Expertise, Governance Capabilities, and Performance in U.S Regional Banks

This study examines how a CEO's environmental background affects performance by managing climate risk within the Basel III framework in 80 small to medium-sized banks. It also examines internal banking strategies that reduce climate risks within regulatory rules. The analysis covers 29 U.S. states highly exposed to climate risk from 2006 to 2020, divided into pre (2006-2009) and post (2010-2020) Basel III implementation periods. The findings suggest that the CEO's environmental-related expertise and knowledge significantly impact the performance of small to medium-sized banks in the post-Basel III era.
