

Alumni Eligibility Policy

King's College London alumni are eligible to access most of our services for two years (24 months) following their course completion date. Beyond this point, alumni retain access to our Careers Centre at the Strand Campus when open, but we are unable to provide other services.

Course completed within the last two years?
