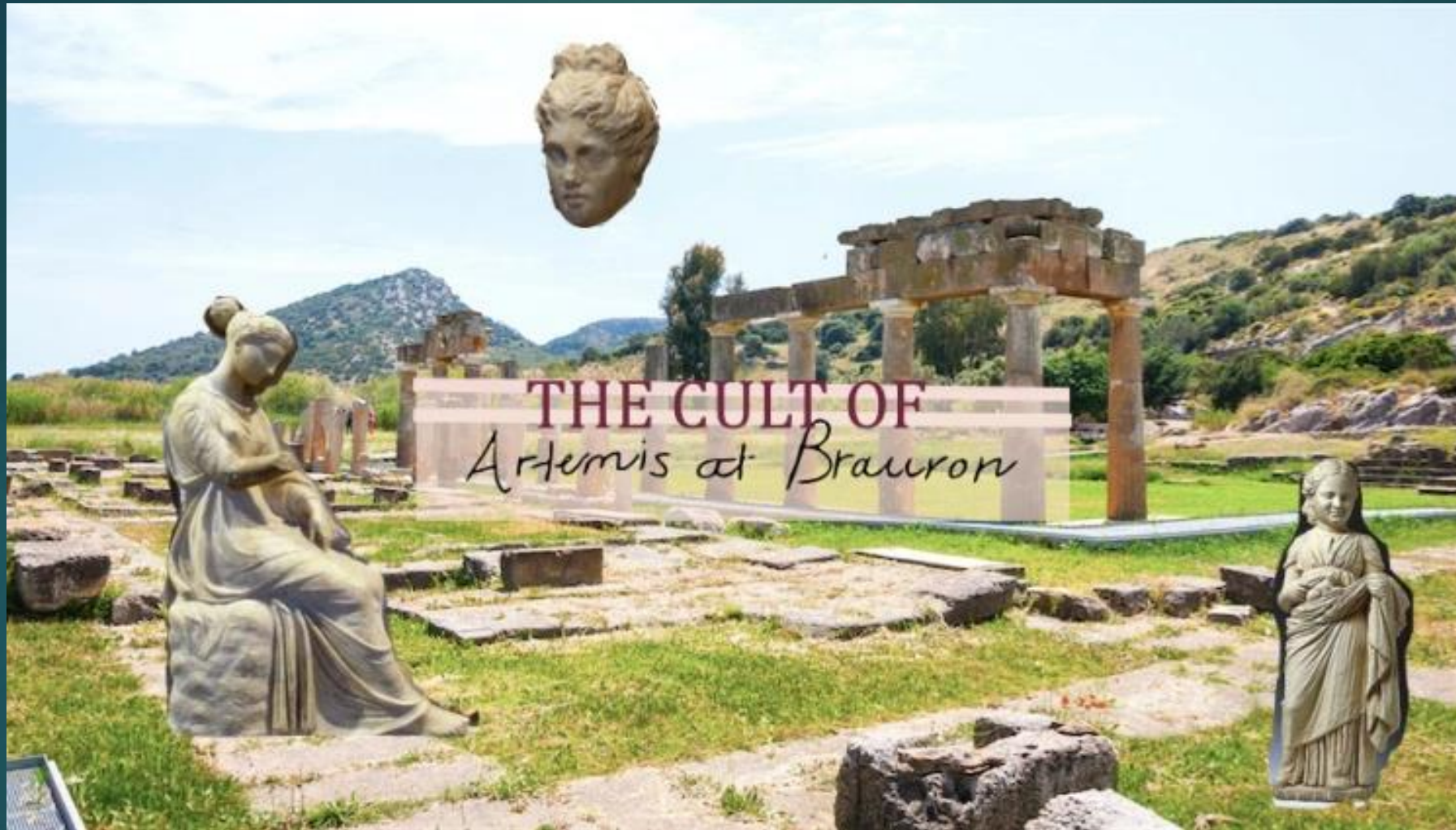

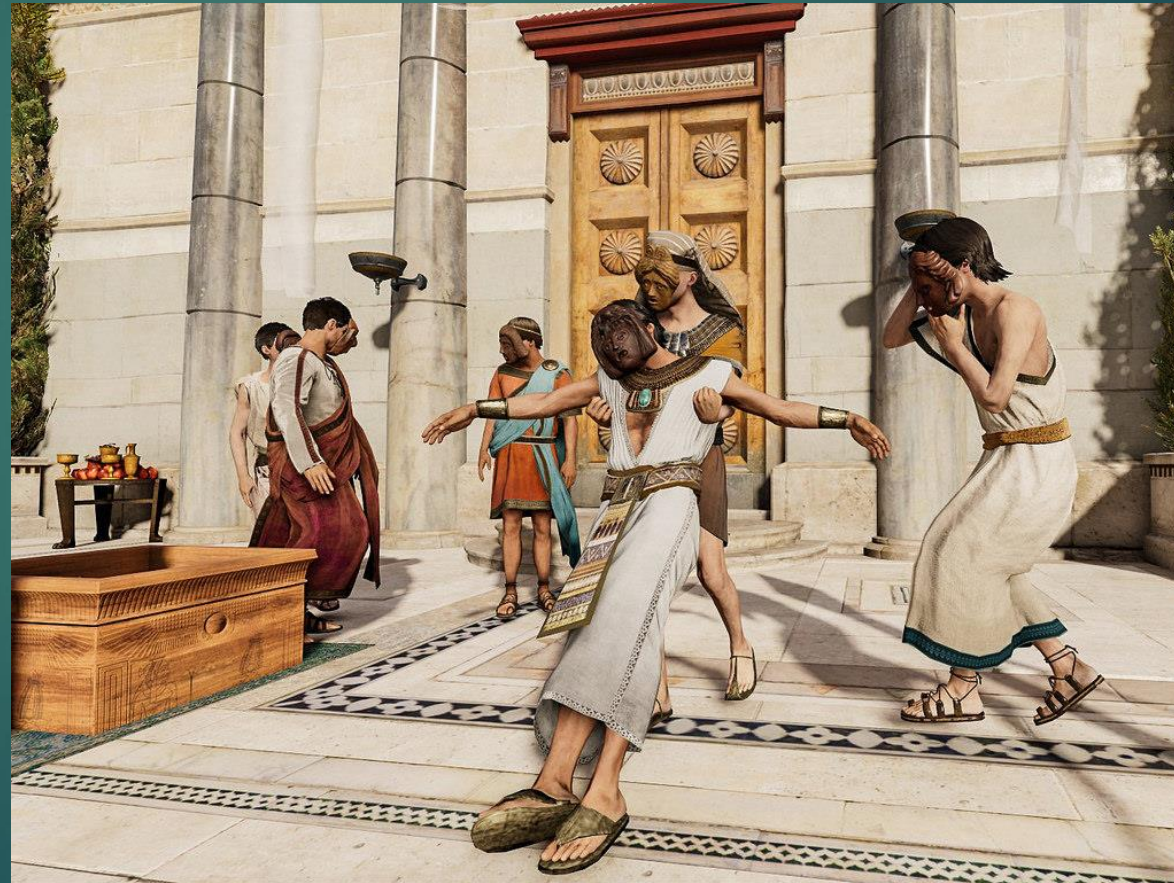
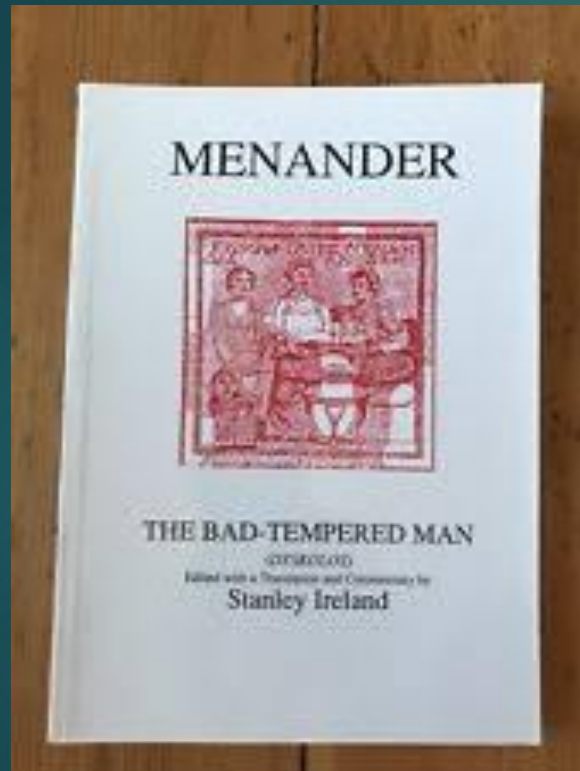


Girls learning textile production in the gynaikeion.

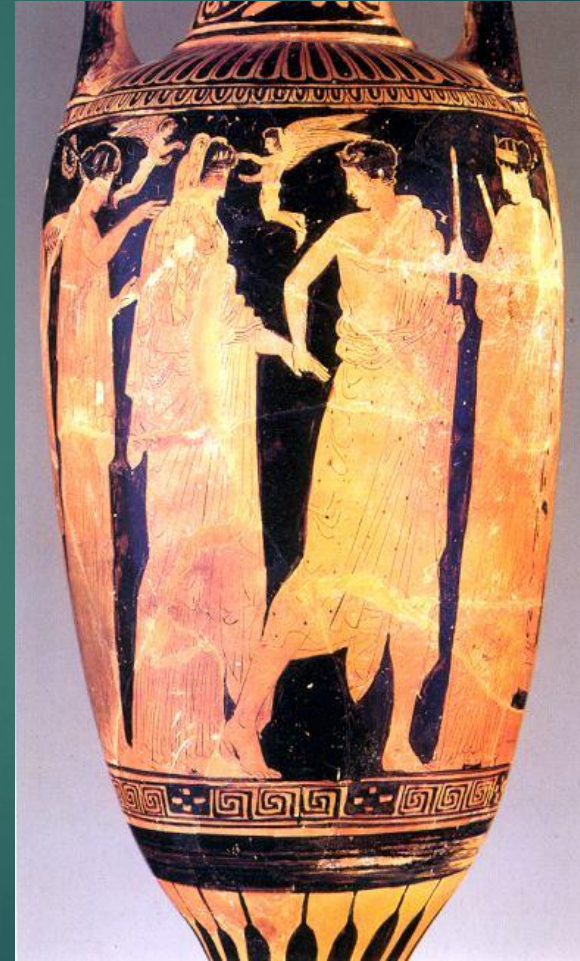
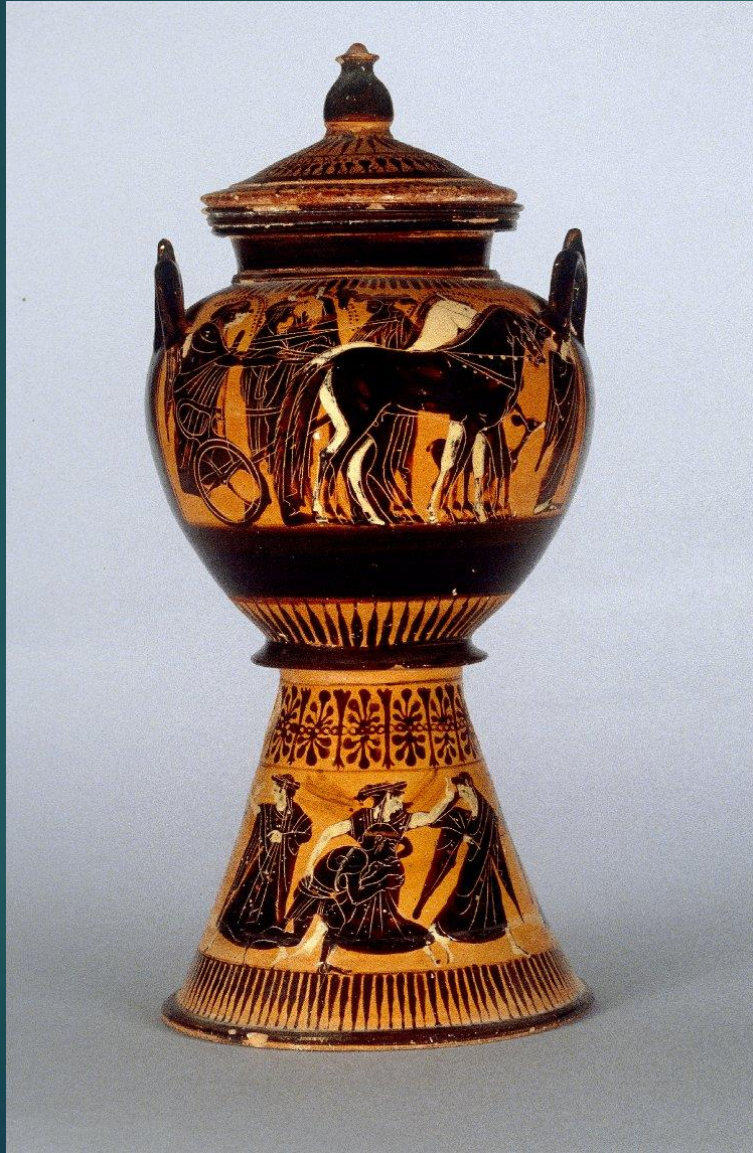




Menander's *Bad-Tempered Man* (*Dyskolos*): two father-and-son pairs marry off their daughters/sisters



Images on the *lebes gamikos* of wedding day



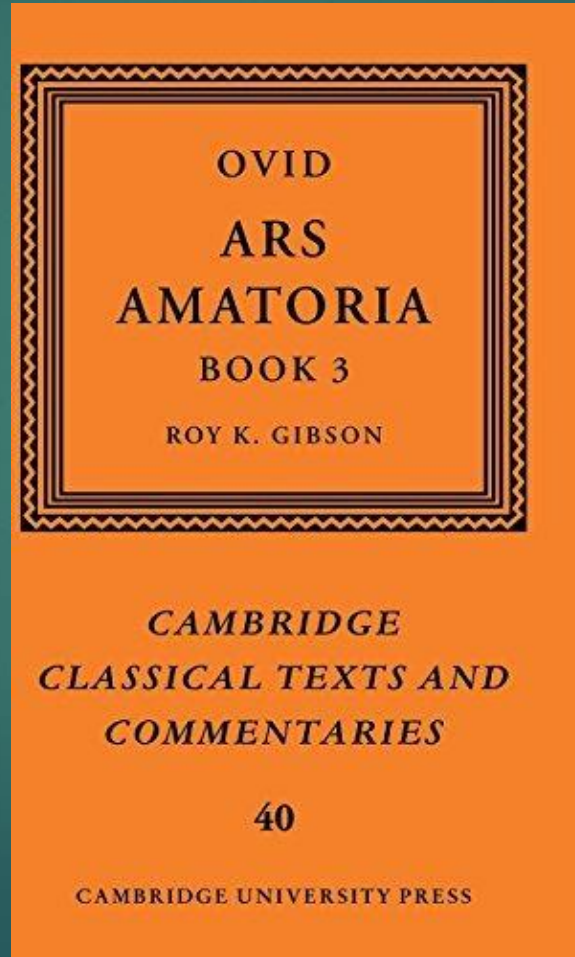
