Takeovers are not designed to replace larger <u>'Spotlight' Promotions</u> which enable you to customise activity in high footfall areas across our campuses.

Takeovers are not designed as a formally-structured space to host presentations or workshops to large groups of students.

We do not permit food or drink promotions in the Strand Careers Centre\* What could you do in the space?

Hold informal discussions or interviews with small groups of potential applicants

Convert King's applicants who may have commenced an application but not completed it, reach out and help them!

Keep warm activity with existing offer holders before they join you in a safe and familiar environment to them around their timetable

When you're not meeting with students, you're welcome to use our private offices to conduct your own work, meet with our team or work with us to share other ideas for recruiting
