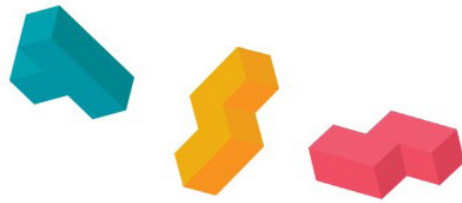

Discover

Depending on which stage of your career journey you are on, you will get different kinds of value from a Careers Fair. If you are in the Discover phase, and still thinking about what you want to do with your career, then you'll find more detail about possible sectors of interest. When you meet employers, try to ask questions that will help you learn more about your suitability for different types of role and sector.

...understand more about the working world and what is expected of a successful graduate in a career to which they are well-matched

Focus

If you are in the Focus phase, then you'll be able to find out much more about the detail of roles you are interested in, such as what skills you will need to apply, and how to use work experience to help you prepare to work in the sector.

...understand what employability assets are required for the roles and sectors that interest me, and explore how to develop myself to meet those needs

...learn what distinguishes successful and employment-ready graduates in sectors that interest me and what that journey of development looks like

If you are in the Action phase, then this is your chance to find out those specific details about the employers and roles you are interested in, to help your applications stand out. Be prepared with thoughtful questions that show that you've already done some research, and have a genuine interest in the people and companies you are talking to.
