Enter via the main entrance on Waterloo Bridge Roundabout.

### London Underground

- Waterloo (Jubilee/Northern/Bakerloo/Waterloo & City): 3 minute walk
- Charing Cross (Bakerloo/Northern): 9 minute walk
- Embankment (District/Circle/Bakerloo): 13 minute walk
- Temple (District/Circle): 20 minute walk

### National Rail

- Charing Cross: 9 minute walk
- Waterloo: 4 minute walk
- Waterloo East: 5 minute walk
- Blackfriars: 17 minute walk

Additionally, both Euston and King's Cross, connecting to the north, are located a short bus ride away whilst St. Pancras International serves international rail services to France, Belgium and The Netherlands and connections across continental Europe.

### Buses

Services that stop at Waterloo Road or nearby are numbers: 1, 4, 26, 59, 68, 76, 77, 139, 168, 171, 172, 188, 243, 341, 507, 521 and SL6 on the Superloop.

### River Boat

Uber Boat by Thames Clippers provide regular river services operate to Blackfriars and Embankment Piers, situated approximately twelve minutes walk from our office.

### Cycling

Various Santander London Cycle Hire scheme docking stations are available nearby including on Waterloo Road.

Bike parking is available in front of the Franklin-Wilkins Building or James Clerk Maxwell Building adjacent to the campus.

### Airports

- London City: approx. 40 minutes by Docklands Light Railway to Bank, then Waterloo & City Line on London Underground
- London Gatwick: approx. 45 minutes by Gatwick Express or Southern Trains to London Victoria.
- London Heathrow: approx. 45 minutes by Heathrow Express to London Paddington or 50 minutes by Elizabeth Line to Tottenham Court Road Station, followed by Northern Line on the London Underground to Waterloo Station.

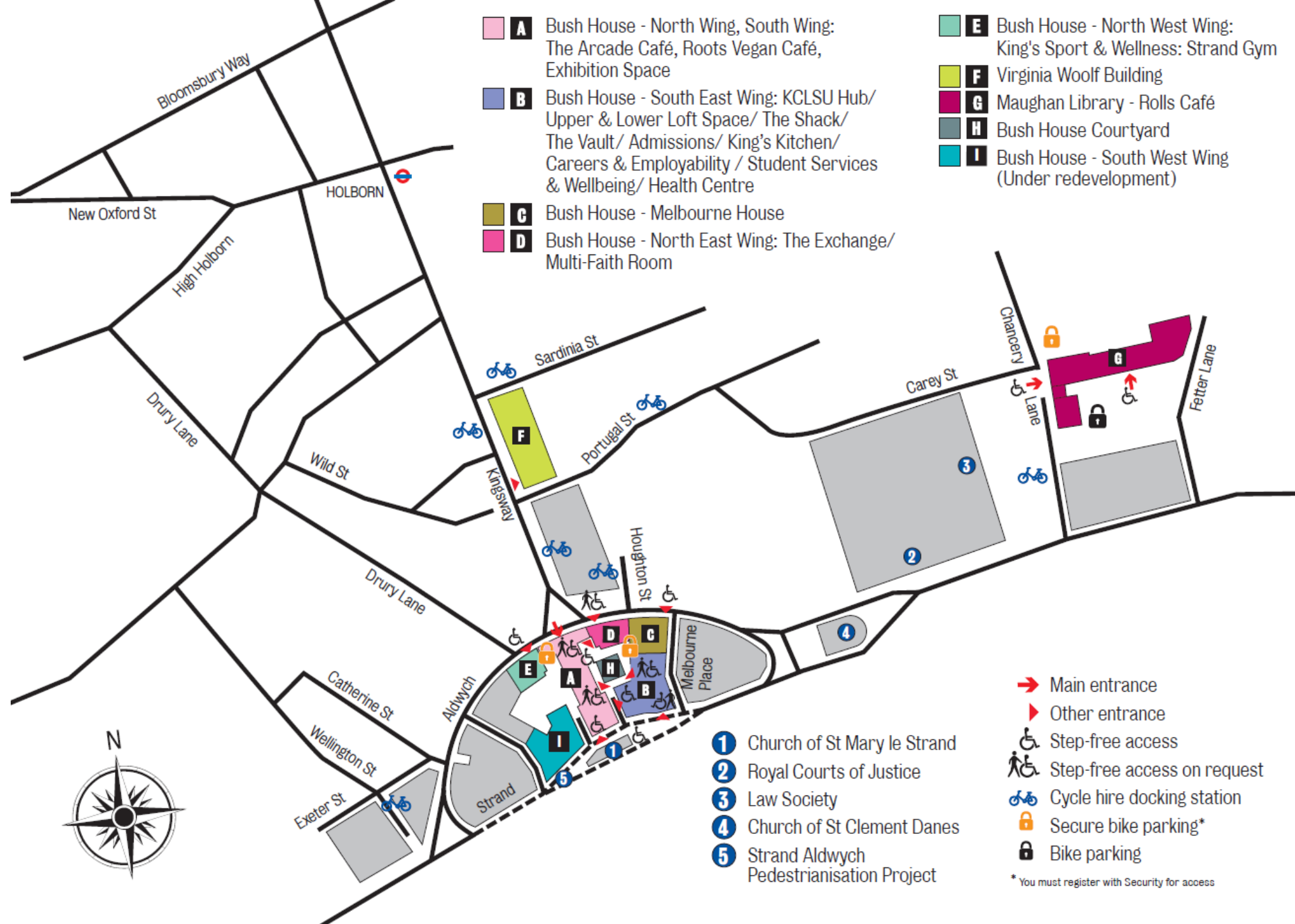
### Driving & Parking

The Waterloo Campus is located within London's ULEZ and Congestion Charge zone with no parking available on campus.

A nearby APCOA car park is on Cornwall Road.

If you need to visit us by vehicle, we recommend using London taxis, a licensed minicab service or ride service hailing network.

*N.B. The Strand Aldwych project has now completed pedestrianisation between Waterloo Bridge and Surrey Street and there is no regular vehicular access to our campuses.*

## London Underground

- Temple (District/Circle): 2 minute walk
- Charing Cross (Bakerloo/Northern): 10 minute walk
- Embankment (District/Circle/Bakerloo): 10 minute walk
- Waterloo (Jubilee/Northern/Bakerloo/Waterloo & City): 12 minute walk
- Holborn (Central/Piccadilly): 12 minute walk
- Chancery Lane (Central): use exit 4 - 15 minute walk

## National Rail

- Charing Cross: 9 minute walk
- Waterloo: 12 minute walk
- Waterloo East: 10 minute walk
- Blackfriars: 12 minute walk

Additionally, both Euston and King's Cross, connecting to the north, are located a short bus ride away whilst St. Pancras International serves international rail services to France, Belgium and The Netherlands and connections across continental Europe.

## Buses

Services that stop on the Aldwych or nearby are numbers:

1, 4, 6, 9, 11, 13, 15, 23, 26, 59, 68, 76, 87, 91, 133, 139, 168, 172, 176, 188, 243, 341 and SL6 on the Superloop.

## River Boat

Uber Boat by Thames Clippers provide regular river services operate to Blackfriars and Embankment Piers, situated approximately eight minutes walk from our office.

## Cycling

Various Santander London Cycle Hire scheme docking stations are available nearby including on Strand and Kingsway.

Bike parking is available on Lincoln's Inn Fields and Clement's Inn Passage across the Aldwych from the campus.

## Airports

- London City: approx. 40 minutes by Docklands Light Railway to Bank, then District Line on London Underground.
- London Gatwick: approx. 45 minutes by Gatwick Express or Southern Trains to London Victoria.
- London Heathrow: approx. 45 minutes by Heathrow Express to London Paddington or 50 minutes by Elizabeth Line to Farringdon Station.

## Driving & Parking

The Strand Campus is located within London's ULEZ and Congestion Charge zone with no parking available on campus. Nearby on-street parking is available on Surrey Street to the south or Lincoln's Inn Fields to the north and an NCP car park is available on Parker Street at the top of Drury Lane.

Motorcycle bays are available in the Strand, Arundel Street, Temple Place and other nearby streets.
