# WHAT IS ENTERPRISE AWARD?

Enterprise Award is one of the King's Experience Awards, run by the King's Entrepreneurship Institute.

It is a co-curricular programme, aimed at supporting students and staff members to develop the [7 Skills of an Entrepreneurial Mindset](#) through a variety of learning experiences and opportunities, which will enhance your future, whatever that might hold.

# WHAT ARE THE KING'S EXPERIENCE AWARDS?

The Experience Awards are opportunities for learning outside the formal curriculum, based on experiential learning, and completing an award will earn you recognition on your

# AM I ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

Enterprise Award is open to all King's students and staff members across all faculties, departments and year of study. It's therefore a great way to meet people you might not normally interact with during your time at King's.

Unfortunately, King's alumni cannot participate in Enterprise Award – but alumni are still welcome to attend our events and workshops – sign up to our [mailing list](#) to hear about them.

# **IS IT FREE TO TAKE PART IN ENTERPRISE AWARD?**

Yes! All our workshops and events are free of charge, and we'll try and signpost you to as many free external events as possible. You'll only pay for anything if you find an event that you want to attend which has a fee attached – but this is completely optional.

# **WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?**

We estimate that Enterprise Award requires a minimum of 40 hours self-led study throughout the year, though of course you're free to do more! Ultimately, the more you put in to Enterprise Award, the more you get out of it, so it's in your interest to embrace the opportunity!

Each criterion has slightly different deadlines, and you'll receive plenty of notice ahead of these.

# **I DON'T HAVE A BUSINESS OR ENTREPRENEURSHIP BACKGROUND/DON'T HAVE A BUSINESS IDEA – IS ENTERPRISE AWARD FOR ME?**

Absolutely! You don't need to be a business student or have any experience in entrepreneurship in order to take part. Enterprise Award is about skill-development – not building a business – and the skills you'll develop are applicable to any degree or future career path. The fact that we're open to students and staff from all faculties means that you'll have the opportunity to meet people you might not otherwise meet whilst at King's.

# WHAT DOES ENTERPRISE AWARD ACTUALLY INVOLVE?

Enterprise Award is a year-long personal journey of learning and self-development, to become a more entrepreneurial version of yourself. The final deadline is 21<sup>st</sup> April 2023, with earlier deadlines below:


There are 7 criteria you need to complete for Enterprise Award:


- Complete a Skills Self-Assessment against our 7 Skills of an Entrepreneurial Mindset (due: end-November 2022)
- Attend an in-person Build Teams workshop (during first semester)
- Attend 4 workshops
- Attend 1 full-day event
- Complete a peer-assessed pitch task (due end-February 2023)
- Undertake 4 hours of independent learning
- Re-assess your skills and write a 1000 word reflective essay about your experience




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
