- 2. The significance of the proposed research;
- 3. Explicit reference to the transnational outlook of the proposed research;
- 4. The likely methodological approach and why it is appropriate to the aims of the project;
- 5. How your proposed research complements your previous experience and anticipates possible future research work;
- 6. Why you feel your project fits with your proposed supervisor's research and the strengths of The Dickson Poon School of Law.

Research proposals must NOT exceed 2 sides of A4 (Times New Roman Font size 11) in total. Longer proposals or those that contain extraneous material will not be considered.
