Request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“the Act”)

Further to your recent request for information held by King’s College London, I am writing to confirm that the requested information is held by the university.

Your request

We received your information request on 7 November 2022 and have treated it as a request for information made under section 1(1) of the Act.

You requested the following information:

Yes it is my intention to make a freedom of information request about the number of Eu students in the undergraduate level of degree please. If it is possible maybe the last four/five years, any statistics on the EU student number of applicants on those specific years.

Please note the below when interpreting the figures:

With regards to 2018 – 2020; We have interpreted this to mean the number of EU applicants who have applied to Undergraduate courses prior to the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union. As a result of the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union and the subsequent Withdrawal Agreement, applicants are no longer recorded as EU after 2020.

With regards to 2021 – 2022; Since 2021 applicants are treated as either Home or Overseas students. Figures provided above therefore relate to applicants who have declared their region as "European Union" for 2021 and 2022.

This completes the university's response to your information request.

Your right to complain
