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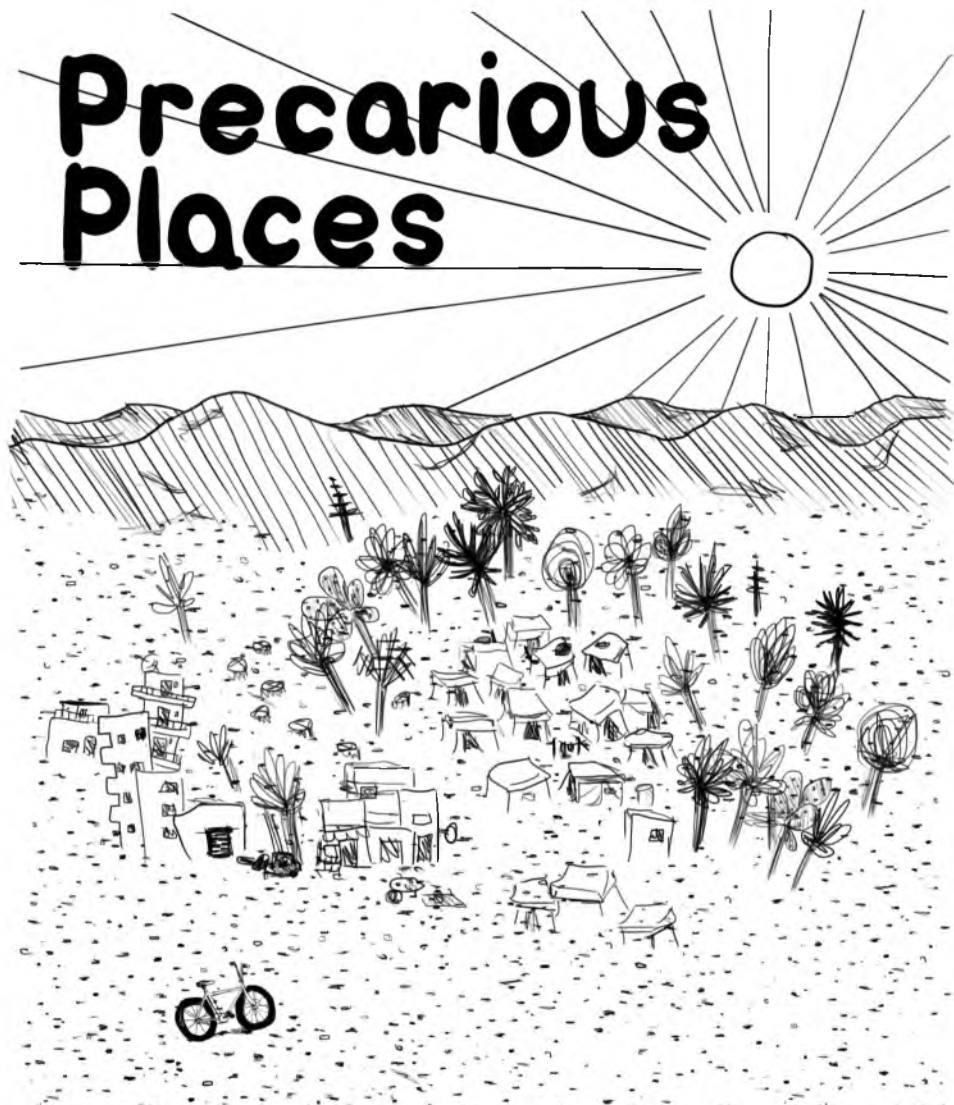

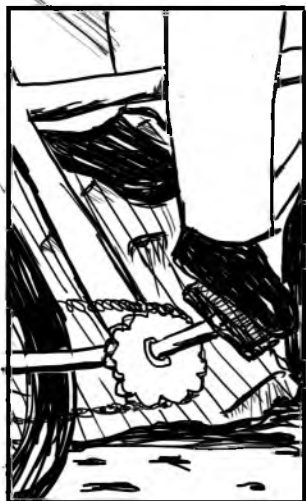

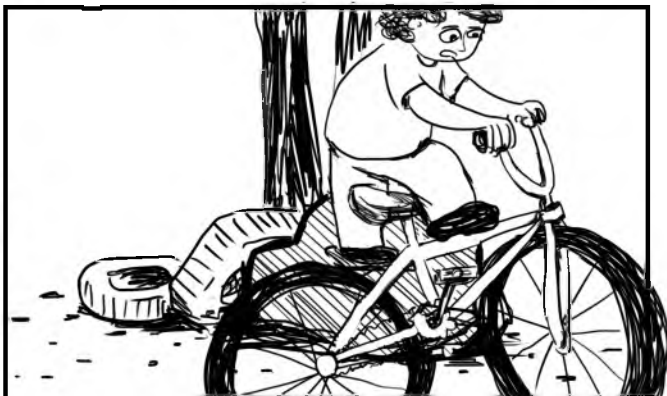
Why, are you even selling this

sun! And I also..



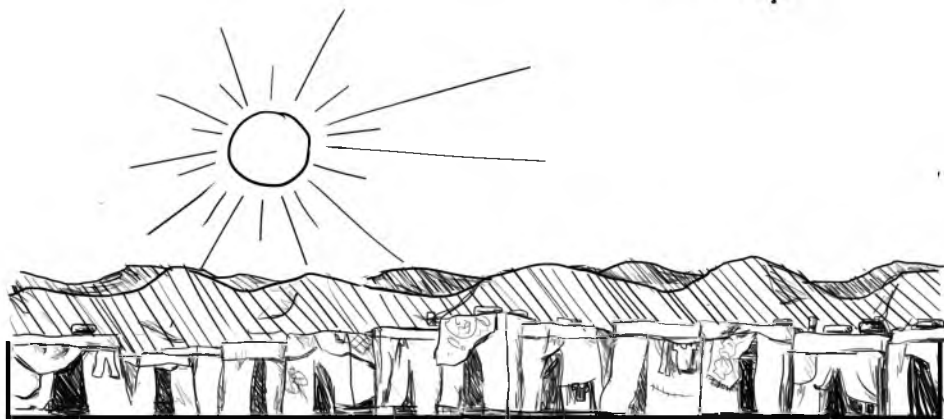
I want to go back to
