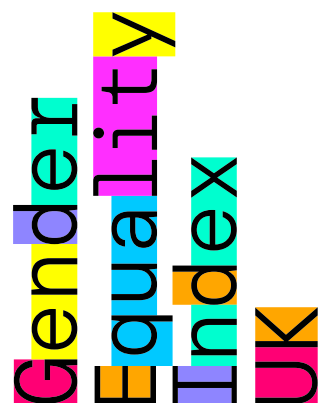

3. Distribution, correlations and results of the Principal Component Analysis by domain

Using Principal Component Analysis (PCA), the aim was to test indicators and obtain symmetry in the latent structure across the three measures. The Women's Outcomes Measure was used as our guiding measure when exploring the latent structure of the index. This is motivated by wanting to centre the GEIUK around women's experiences, and the historical discrimination and inequalities they have faced. To achieve the same structure for each of our three measures, the structure was first developed on Women's Outcomes Measure and subsequently checked for adequate fit with the other two measures.

We have sufficient cases – 372 overall – to perform a PCA and no outliers, meeting the thresholds set out by the different rules of thumb set by methodologists (Gorsuch, 2013; Bryant and Yarnold, 1995). Using a covariance and (standardised) correlation matrix, the PCA shows the association between indicators and how these may relate to each other (OECD and Joint Research Centre, 2008). The number of factors – which correspond to the number of subdomains to consider for aggregation – is based on the Kaiser criterion of eigenvalues being greater than 1 as a guide, and rotated factors loadings typically above 0.5. We use the sampling-adequacy measure Kaiser–Meyer–Olkin (KMO) to assess the measure of fit, producing moderate fits across our domains with KMO values approaching or slightly exceeding 0.5. While the results of the PCA did not fully meet accepted thresholds, they still provide useful guides for aggregation. The robustness of the results, however, is further assessed by analysing the correlation structure of the indicators, domains and index.

Figure 1. Distribution and correlations of indicators in the domain of Paid Work.

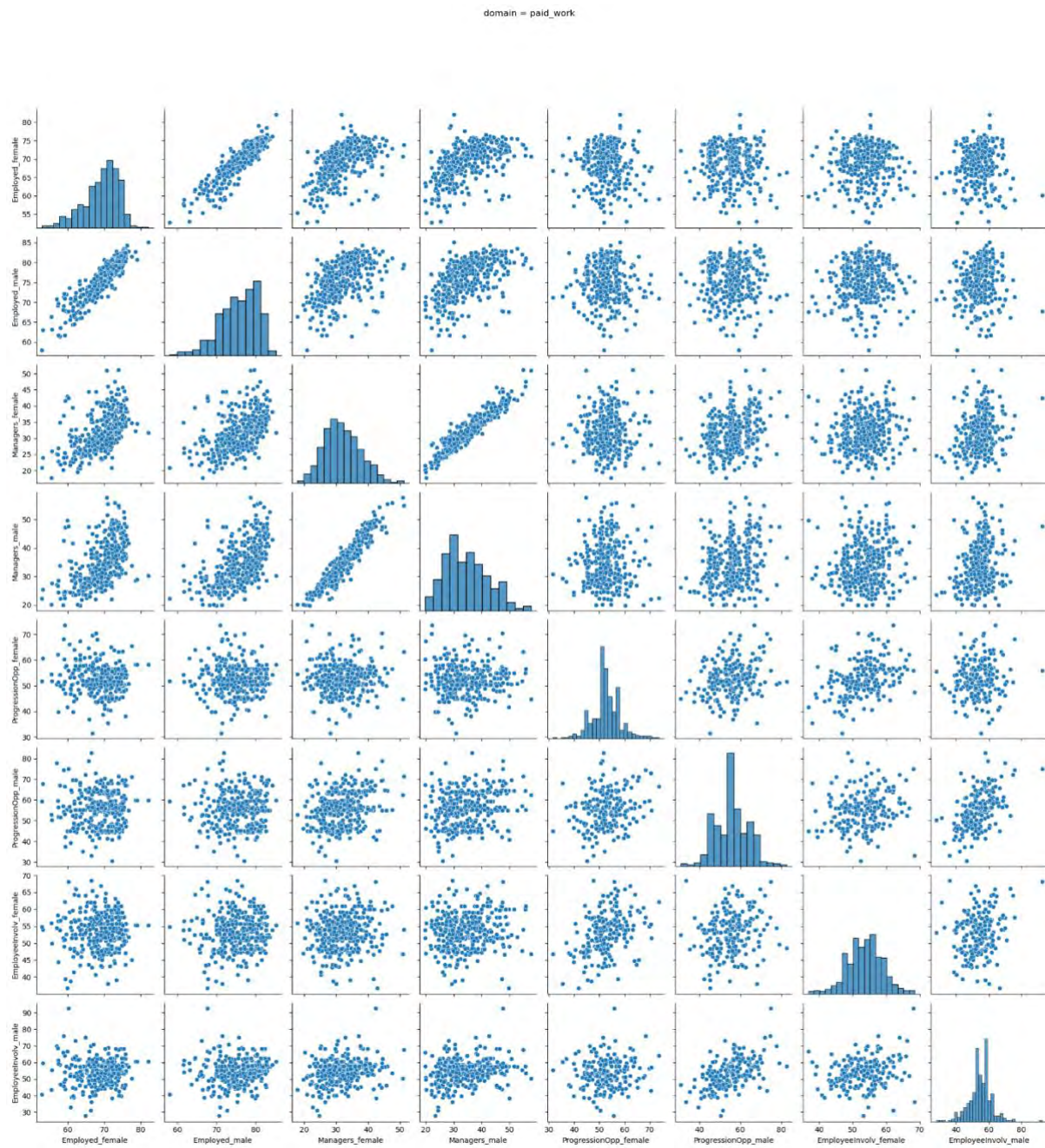

Figure 2. Distribution and correlations of indicators in the domain of Unpaid Work.

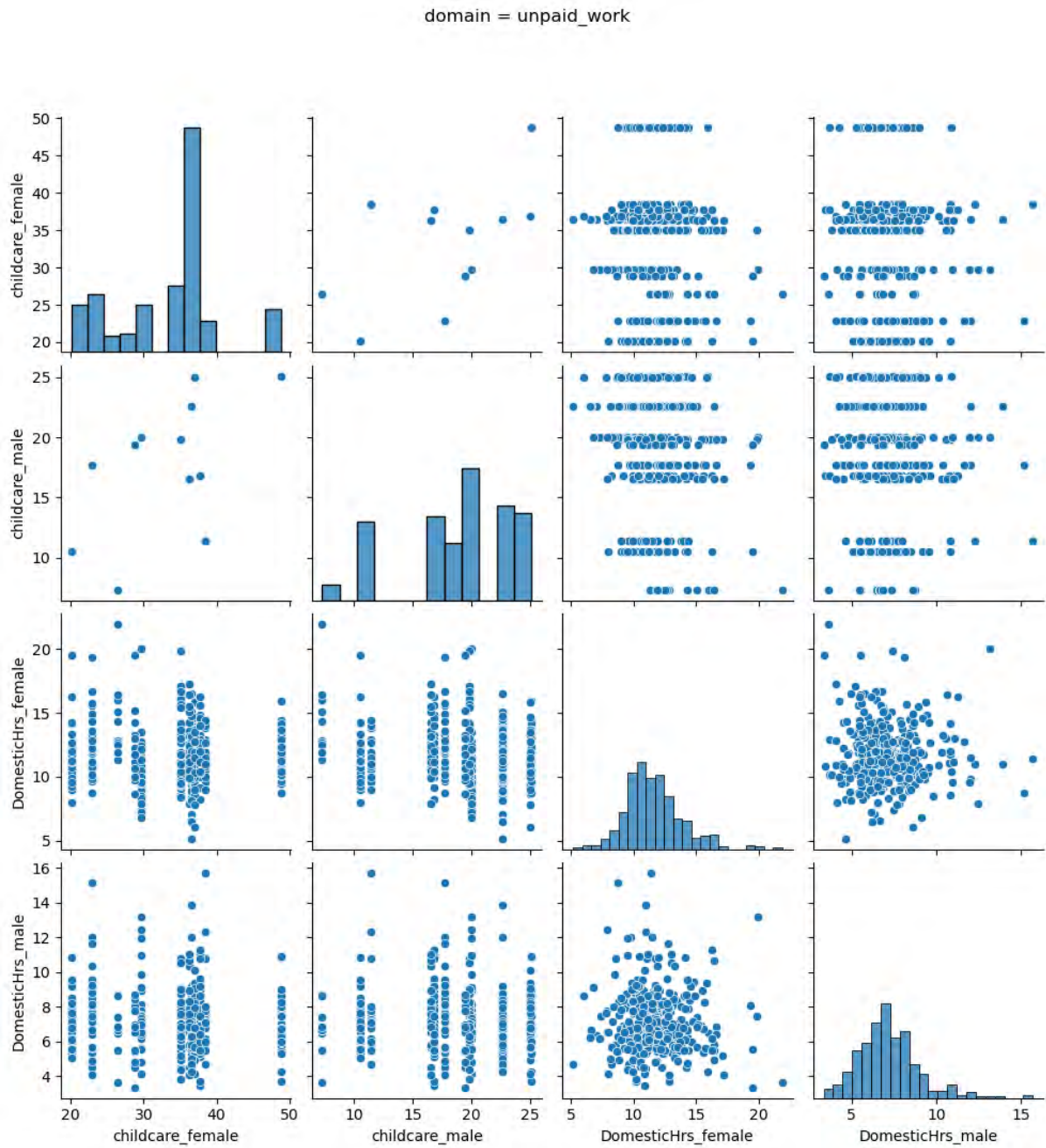

Figure 3. Principal Components - Rotated factor loadings for Unpaid Work indicators (one component solution).

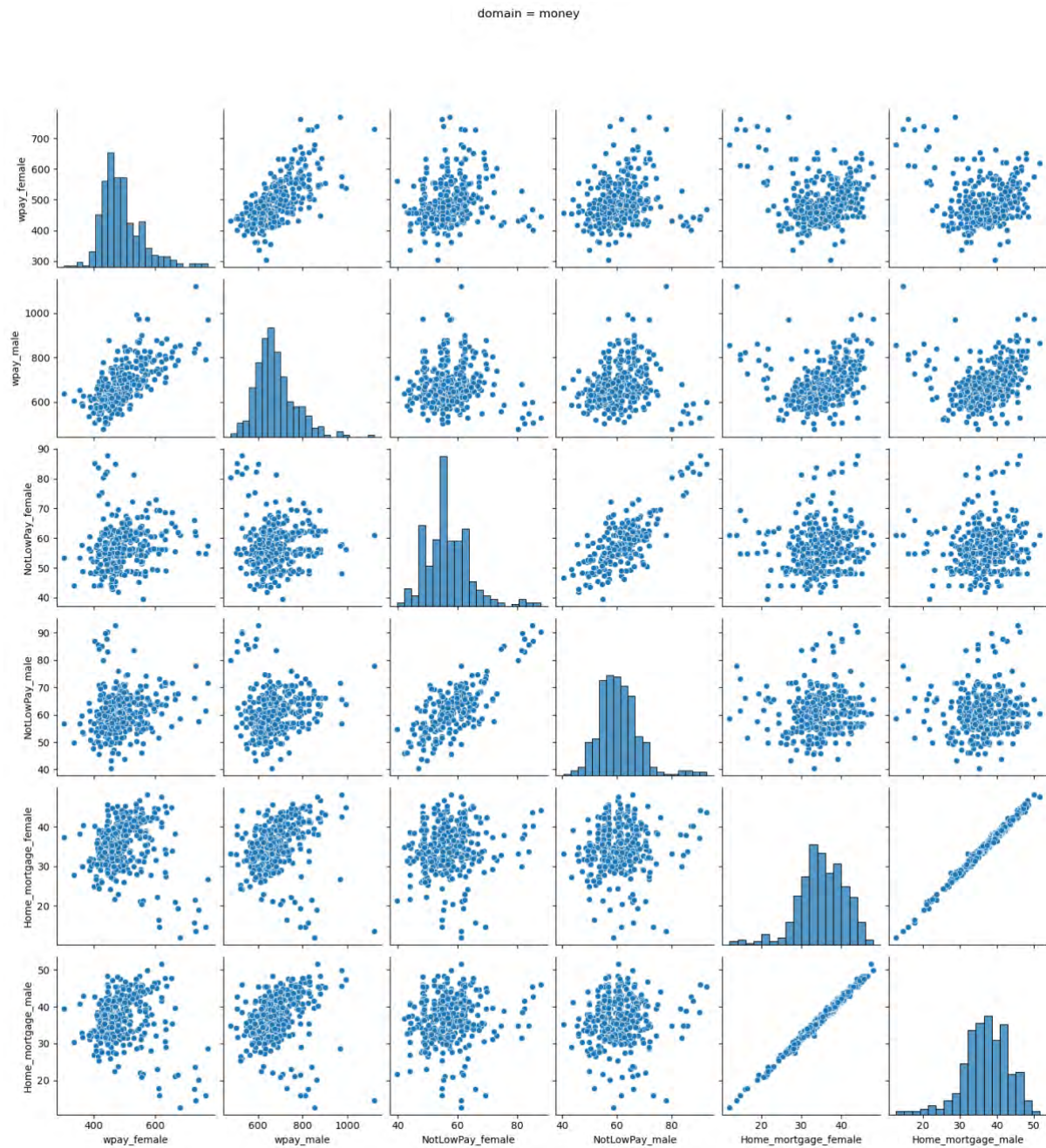

Figure 4. Distribution and correlations of indicators in the domain of Power & Participation.

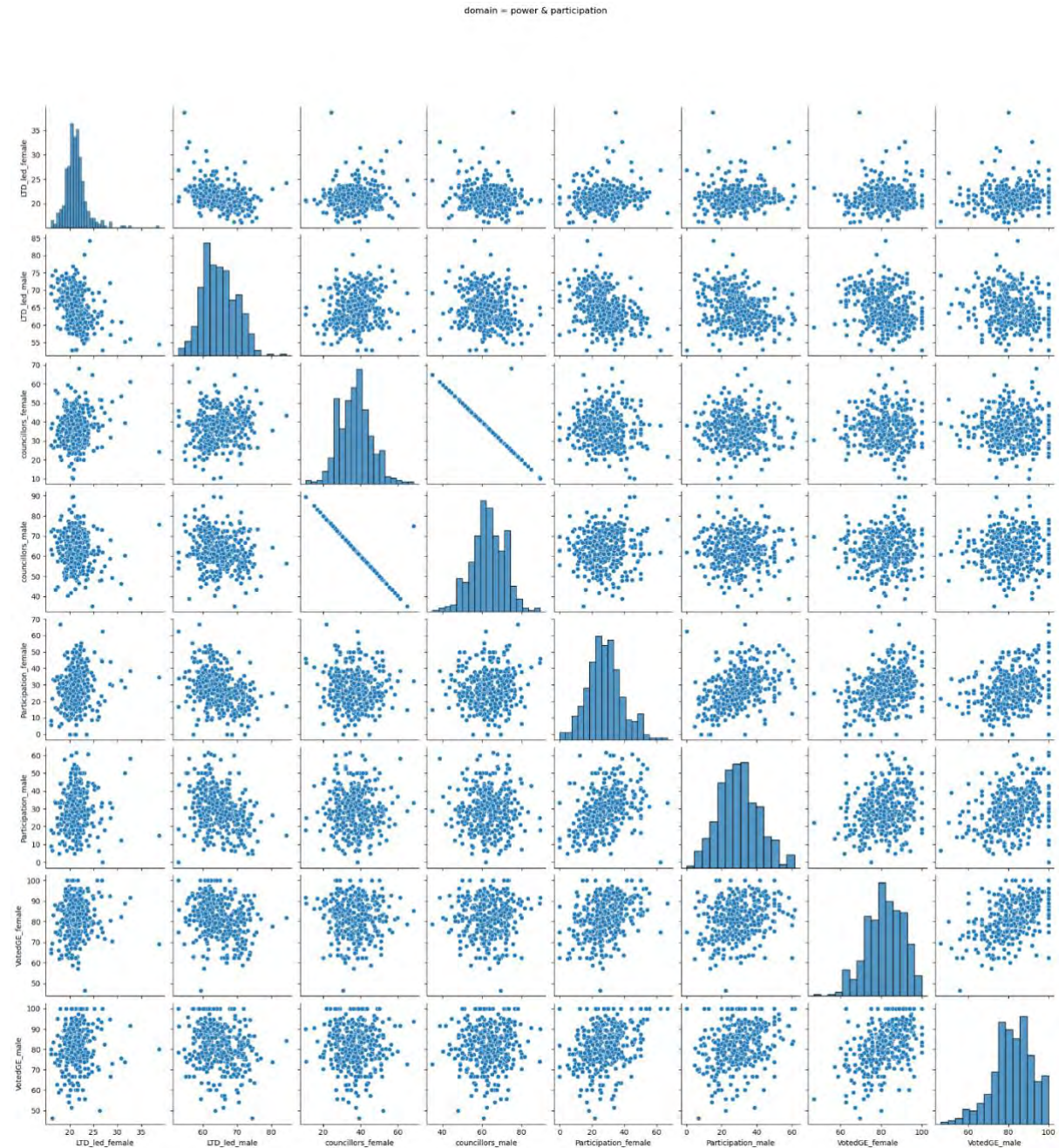

Figure 5. Distribution and correlations of indicators in the domain of Education.

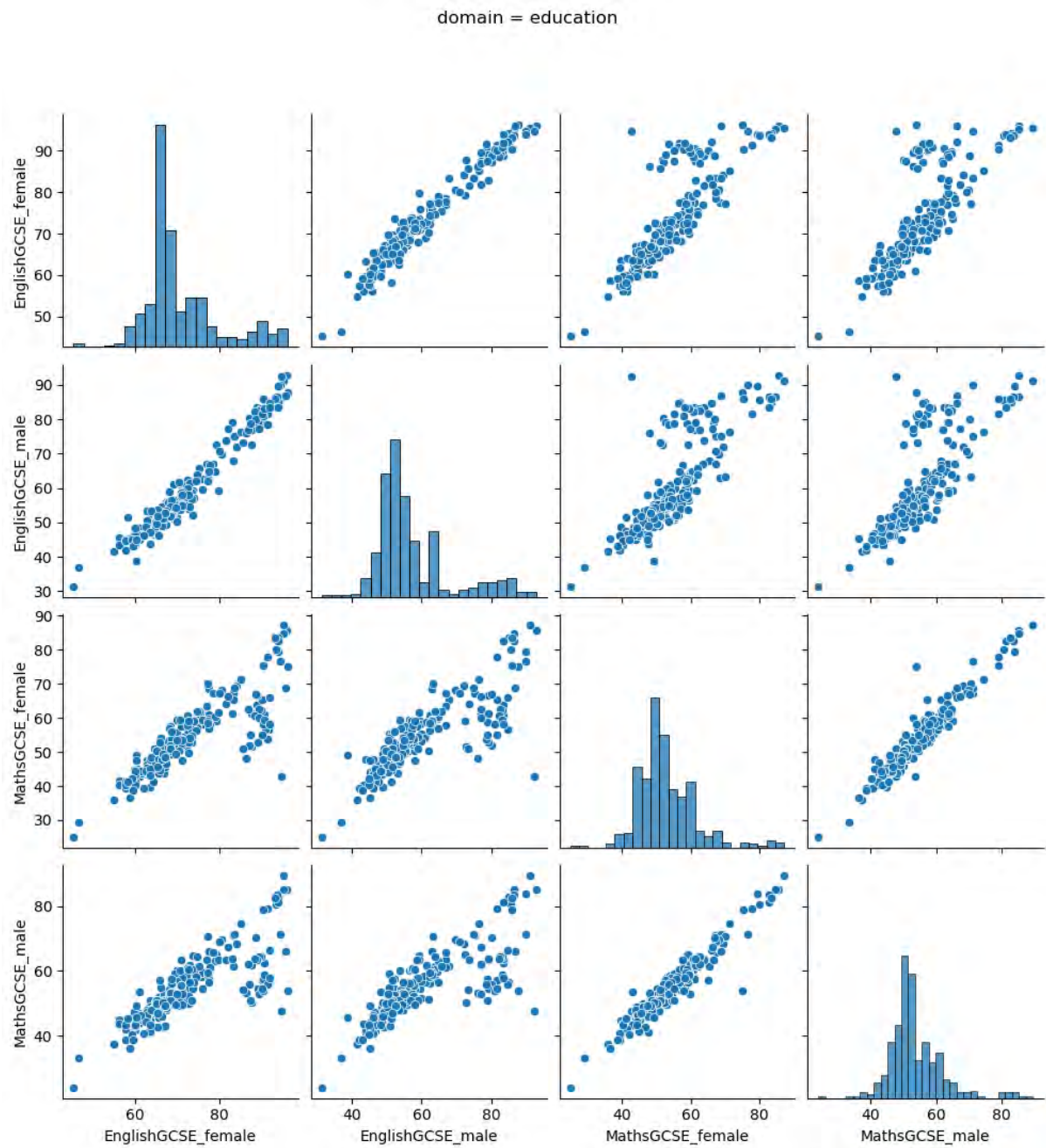

Figure 6. Distribution and correlations of indicators in the domain of Health.

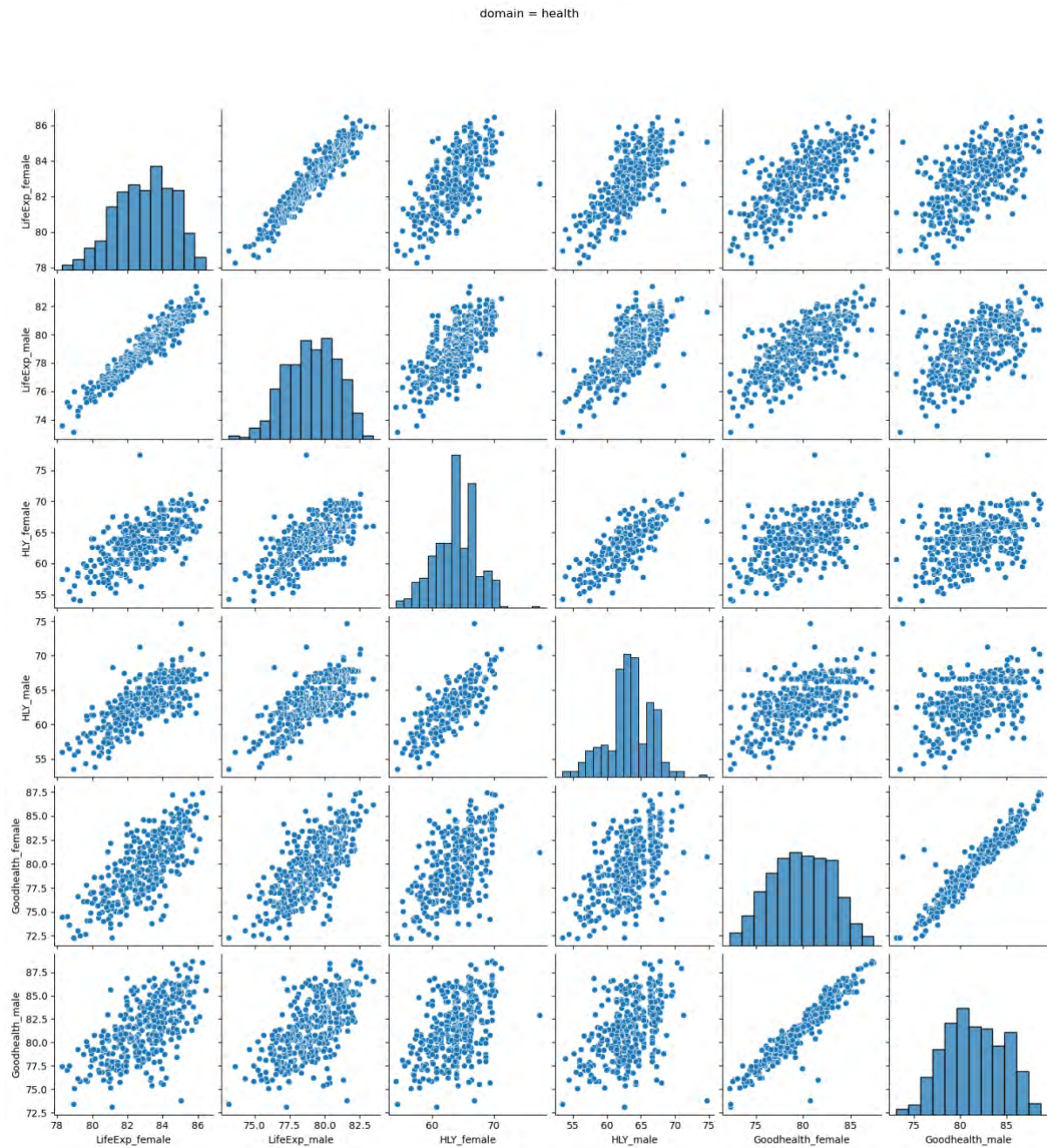

4. Testing alternative aggregation and weighting approaches

Alternative aggregation approaches were tested. In addition to the arithmetic mean, we applied the geometric mean to aggregate at the domain and/or index level, as well as adjusted weights by factoring in the number of indicators included in each domain. The graphs below show little variation in the overall index scores for each of our measures. Given the minimal difference between the approaches, we selected the arithmetic mean and equal weights as this allows for easier interpretation of our scores.

Figure 7. Women's Outcomes Measure - Comparison of scores resulting from different aggregation and weighting approaches.

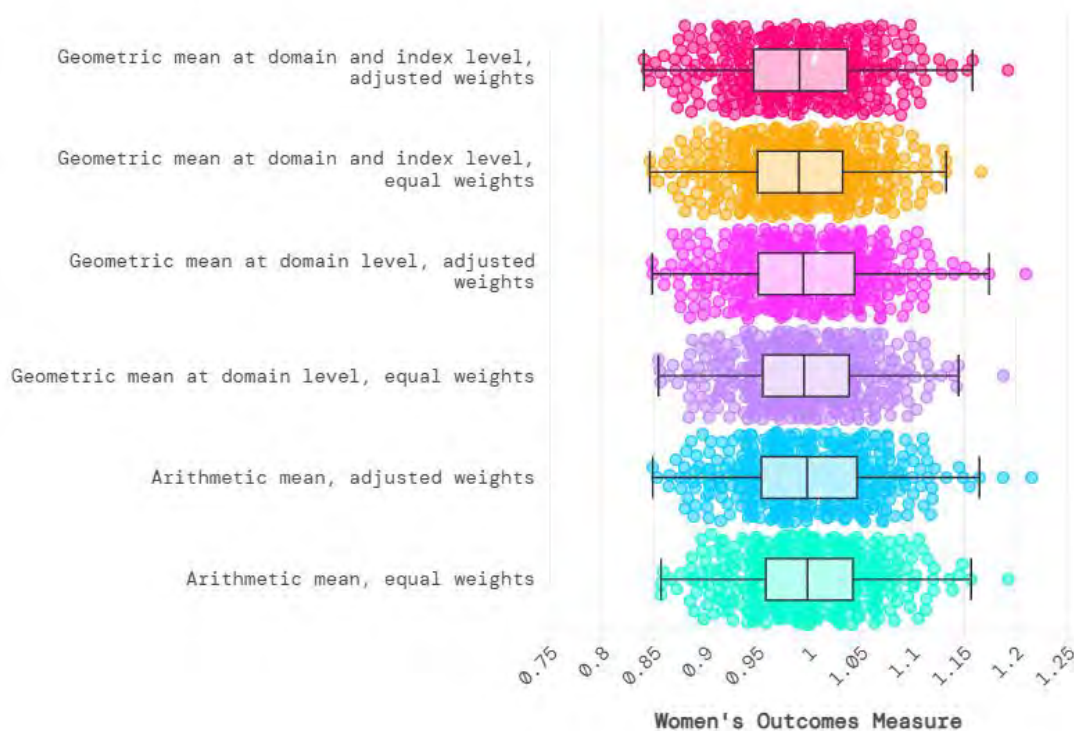


Figure 8. Men's Outcomes Measure - Comparison of scores resulting from different aggregation and weighting approaches.

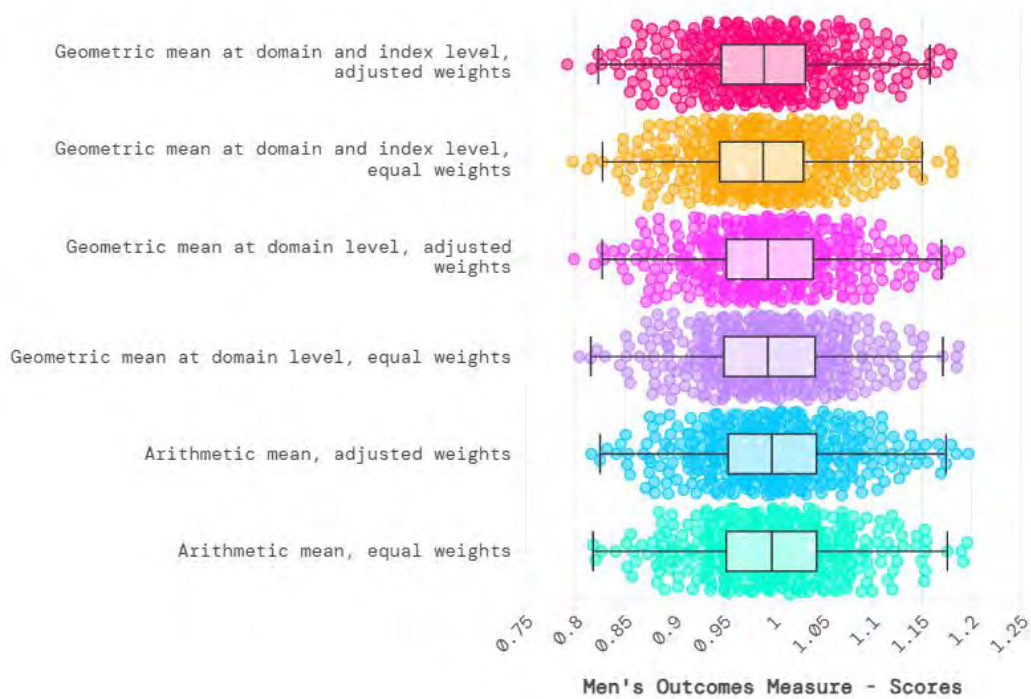
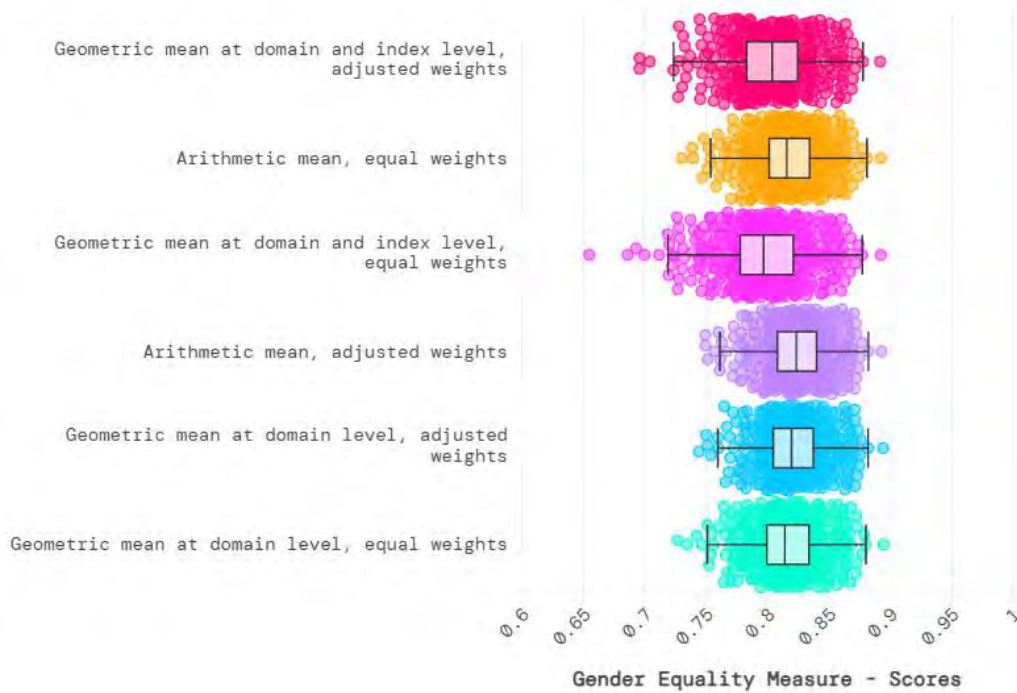


Figure 9. Gender Equality Measure - Comparison of scores resulting from different aggregation and weighting approaches.



5. Quality assessment

5.1 Correlation matrices

The correlation structure of all three measures was assessed following the guidelines from the OECD and JRC (2008). In the Women's Outcomes Measure, we find acceptable correlations, with few strong positive and no strong negative correlations within each of the respective domain structures. Further examination of the correlation structure shows that there is at least moderate (i.e., 0.4 or above) correlation between most indicators and the domain they measure, and between these domains and the overall index. The only exception is the domain of unpaid work, which does not contribute to the overall index.

The Men's Outcomes Measure does not show any strong negative correlations within the domain structures. Compared with the Women's Outcomes Measure, fewer of the indicators contribute to the domains they measure, suggesting that the configurational equality model used for women does not fully apply to men's lives. However, all domains contribute to the overall index.

The Gender Equality Measure shows no strong positive correlations nor negative correlations between indicators (measuring the gender gap in outcomes). Several of the indicators do not strongly contribute to their domain score. The domains of *Unpaid Work* and *Power & Participation* are the only domains that contribute to the index score, suggesting that variation in gender gaps is driven predominantly by these two domains.

These results are interesting when considering the three measures together. For both the Women's and Men's Outcomes Measure, we see that each of the domains contributes to the overall index score, apart from *Unpaid Work* in the case of the former. This could be interpreted as an indication of universality in the time spent on unpaid work amongst women and amongst men respectively in the UK, although caution is needed when interpreting this, given that the indicator measuring domestic work contains small sample sizes for certain localities and that the childcare indicator is measured on the regional level. In contrast, the domain of Unpaid Work contributes to the Gender Equality Measure, which can be interpreted as a strong driver of inequalities between women and men. In other words, these results suggest that inequalities in relation to Unpaid Work are less about inequalities within women or men as a group, and instead more relevant to inequalities between women and men.

The contribution of the domain of Power to the Gender Equality Measure also suggests that a key driver of gender inequalities between women and men is that of equal voice and representation. However, in this case, it is not only inequalities between women and men that appear to matter, but also inequalities within women and men, as demonstrated by the strong contributions of this domain to both the Women's Outcomes Measures and the Men's Outcomes Measures.

5.2 Robustness checks

The robustness of the GEIUK was assessed by recalculating the overall score while omitting each domain in turn. This allows us to check for the stability of the results and ensure that one domain does not predominantly drive the results of the index. Table 18 and Table 19 show examples of the score range by domain for the top 30 observations.

The range of the scores across domains iteratively omitted is 0.01 and 0.16 for the Women's Outcomes Measure, with an average range of 0.06. The Men's Outcomes Measure range was 0.01 to 0.20, with an average of 0.6. Finally, for the Gender Equality Measure ranged from 0.03 to 0.15, with an average of 0.8. While there are differences aligned with the correlation structure, the results of these checks confirm that the GEIUK's overall results are sufficiently robust since differences remain relatively small for most LADs.
