

How to get to the Genomics Centre at the Franklin-Wilkins Building

The Franklin-Wilkins Building is located near the South Bank at the end of Waterloo Bridge, nearby to the iMax cinema and Waterloo station. Stamford Street itself is a turning off of the iMax roundabout.

Parking

There is an APCOA Car Park  located on Cornwall Road next to the Building.

Public Transport

We are located near to Waterloo rail and tube station. There are various exits from Waterloo station, all in different places. The following are the best ones to use...

Waterloo Bridge (Main) exit: **A** Head down the street towards York Road, and turn right towards the iMax. Stamford Street is directly opposite York Road on the other side of the iMax.

Waterloo Road exit: **B** Turn left out of the exit, cross Waterloo Road and continue towards the iMax. Stamford Street is a right turn from the roundabout.

York Road (Tube only) exit: **C** Turn left towards the iMax roundabout. Stamford Street is directly opposite York Road on the other side of the iMax.

Building Access

The Main Entrance is located on Stamford Street. However, if you need to bring heavy machinery, equipment or other packages to the Centre, please use the Goods Entrance on Doon Street, at the rear of the Building. If you do intend to use this entrance please let us know in advance.

Finding the Genomics Centre

We are located on the third floor of the Building. Turn right out of the lift lobby onto the main River corridor and look for Corridor **D**, which is on the right hand side. When you reach the end of the corridor, please call either of the extension numbers (4286 (office) or 4263 (lab)) from the internal phone provided and someone will come and get you. Staff at the Reception desk on the first floor near the main entrance will be able to help if you get lost.
