The winning photos will be featured at our inaugural, flagship China Week (last week of October), showcased in a photography exhibition on campus at King's College London.

COMPETITION THEME

'China, the Environment & Climate Change'

The photography exhibition aims to use photography to raise awareness about environmental issues in China. KCL students and staff are be invited to send in photos, which reflects the theme of the environment and/or climate change issues in China.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- File size limit is 1GB
- Photo resolution: at least 300 pixels per inch (PPI)
- You can submit your photo through the Microsoft Form here.
- Entrants must be King's staff, students or alumni

KEY DATES

- The photography call opens the 12th of July
- All submissions must be uploaded through the Microsoft form by 11:59pm London time on Wednesday 15th of September 2021.
- The chosen photos will be announced prior the Lau China Institute's China Week from 25th-29th October 2021

PRIZE

- The winning photographer writer will receive £250; plus the photo will be on display at King's College London during the Lau China Institute's 'China Week' and shared across the Lau China Institute's social media platforms.
