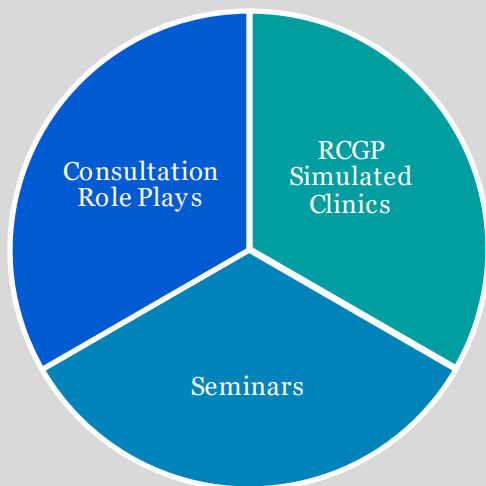
Campus Based Teaching

Campus based teaching is arranged through our Teacher Availability Form on our database and occasionally on an ad-hoc basis, paid per hour, with time for preparation and reflection added (typically an hour). We prioritise teachers who are part of our established teaching network (e.g., those that take students in practice) and those with educational experience and qualifications.

Campus based teaching is small group teaching with 4-10 students. We encourage a facilitative style of teaching, encouraging students to debate and find answers to their own questions. Resources, briefings and training are provided for campus-based teaching sessions.

Other non-paid opportunities such as MBBS interviewing, and paid opportunities via the medical school (separate rate) including OSCE examining, communication skills and Interprofessional Education (IPE) teaching



Our main practice-based teaching opportunities

Stage 2 (Year 2)

Longitudinal placement with a group of 8 students. 21 taught days, one day/week (Tues or Fri)

Early exposure to General Practice to encourage future GPs

£22,880 for each group



Stage 3 (Final Year)

8-week block of teaching, 1:1 with the student

Students consult 5 sessions per week including 1 tutorial (approx. 25 – 30 patients)

£5,500 per student (Total of £18,000 for practices taking a student in all three blocks)



Other practice-based opportunities include the iBSc in Primary care, QIPs, Career Development Period (CDP) and Elective for stage 3 students

Stage 2 Year 2 Campus Based Teaching Opportunities

6 campus days, spread throughout the Stage 2 academic year, facilitating early exposure to General Practice; developing clinical reasoning, clinical examinations and putting it all together. They are usually held at the RCGP with simulated patients (actors). Briefings on the day. **2023 dates: 19th & 22nd Sep; 21st & 24th Nov**
2024 dates: 27th Feb; 1st March; 9th & 12th April (fall on Tuesdays and Fridays). Day rate £520.

Stage 3 (final year) Campus Based Teaching Opportunities

Facilitators for simulated GP clinics at the RCGP, at the beginning of each GP block. Dates for this academic year: Tuesday 13th June, Tuesday 22 August and Tuesday 17 October 2023. Facilitators for GP seminars which are held weekly during weeks 2-8 of the blocks. These continue to take place remotely via MSTeams.

Stage 2 Year 3 Campus Based Teaching Opportunities

Simulated clinics at the RCGP, 2023 dates: Friday 15th September, Friday 10th November. 2024 dates: Friday 2nd February, Wednesday 10th April
