

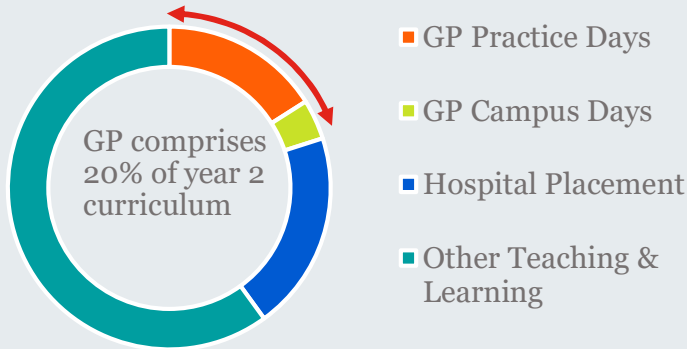
Stage 2 GP Longitudinal Placement

Placement Aims

The longitudinal GP placement in Stage 2 (Year 2) focuses on how people, their health and illness and concerns are managed in the General Practice setting. It will comprise 1 day each week of students' studies in Year 2, and will act as a foundation for the 8-week block GP placement in Stage 3. Students will be placed in a group of 8 students to work together to develop teamwork and leadership skills whilst on placement.



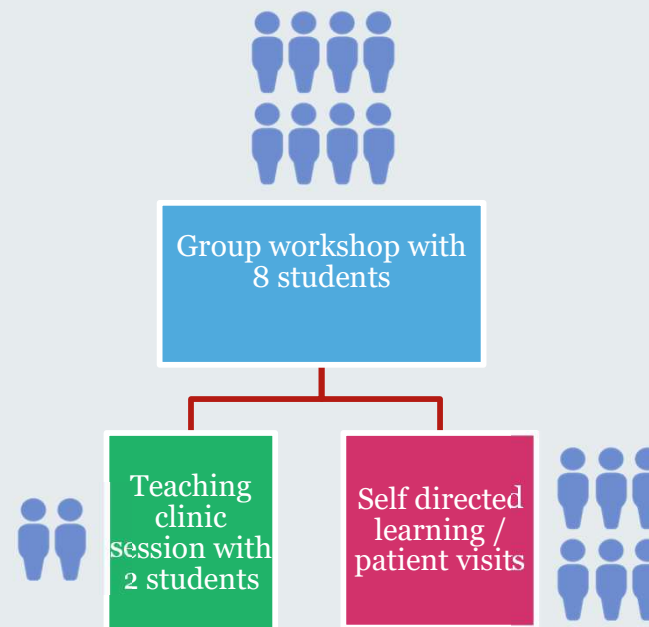
GP Campus Topics
