

Space 4 All Challenge - Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

The Space 4 All Challenge (the "Competition") is organised by The Centre for Human & Applied Physiological Sciences at King's College London (the "Organiser"). By entering the Competition, participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

2. Eligibility

The Competition is open to both individuals and teams from around the world. The Competition has three age categories for participation: Primary (5-11 years), Secondary (12-17 years), and Open Age. Teams can have a maximum of 30 participants

3. Entry Process

To enter, participants email their entry to Space4All@kcl.ac.uk by the deadline of December 3rd 2025, 12:00 noon (UK Time). Each participant or team may submit only one entry. Entries must be the original work of the participant(s).

4. Submission Requirements

All submissions must comply with the formatting and content guidelines provided on the Competition webpage. Entries must not contain any offensive, inappropriate, or plagiarised content. Any submission that does not meet the requirements may be disqualified at the discretion of the Organiser.

5. Intellectual Property

By submitting an entry, participants affirm that they own all intellectual property rights to their submission or have obtained the necessary permissions to use any third-party content included in their entry. Participants retain ownership of their submissions; however, by entering the Competition, participants grant the Organiser a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to use, publish, display, and distribute their submission for promotional, educational, or other non-commercial purposes related to the Competition.

6. Judging Criteria

Submissions will be judged based on the following criteria: Accessibility and Inclusivity (40%), Clarity (30%) and Creativity (30%). The judging panel will consist of a diverse range of experts, and their decisions are final and binding. The Organiser reserves the right to not award a prize if no entries meet the required standards.

7. Prizes

Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or other alternatives. Winners will be notified by email in early 2026. Winners must respond within one week

(7 days) of notification.

8. Disqualification

The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant who breaches these Terms and Conditions, submits false information, or engages in any form of misconduct that may harm the integrity of the Competition. Late submissions, submissions that do not comply with the guidelines, or entries that are incomplete or corrupted will be automatically disqualified.

9. Privacy

Personal information provided by participants will be collected, stored, and used in accordance with King's College London's Privacy Policy. The Organiser will not share personal with third parties without the participant's consent, except as required by law or for the purpose of administering the Competition.

10. Limitation of Liability

The Organiser is not responsible for any technical failures, human errors, or other issues that may prevent the proper submission or judging of entries. By entering the Competition, participants agree to release and hold harmless the Organiser from any claims, damages, losses, or liabilities arising from or related to their participation in the Competition or the acceptance or use of any prize.

11. Amendments

The Organiser reserves the right to modify or update these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any changes will be posted on the Competition website and will take effect immediately upon posting.
