

2. The DISCs

Say to the patient:

- The grey circles show how sad or depressed you feel.
[Indicate the clear circle at the bottom]
- The bottom circle shows no sadness or depression.
[Indicate the fully shaded circle at the top]
- The top circle shows sadness or depression as bad as it can be.
[Pointing at each circle in ascending order]
- As you go from the bottom circle to the top, you can see that sadness or depression is becoming more and more severe.
- Which of these circles shows how sad or depressed you feel today?
