Key terms

- A lecture is a tutor-directed, large group teaching session.
- A webinar is a tutor-directed, medium sized teaching session.
- A seminar is a tutor-directed small group teaching and discussion session, typically with 12 –16 students.
- A tutorial is small group academic support session providing feedback on your studies and progress. It is generally in a small group of 3 to 4 students.
- Independent study is time when you will work on your own to prepare homework tasks, write assessments, and review your online lessons.
- Online tutor-directed classes are lessons pre-made by a tutor that are online and that must be completed ahead of your live classes.
- Student support hour is an opportunity to drop in and speak to your tutor about any non-academic issues you may be having.
