




## **Ticketing Information and Mobility Assistance**

- Advance Tickets will be available for £2.50 from various pensioner groups around the Borough (phone **020 8690 7869** to see if and when we are coming to your group).
- Alternatively, tickets are available at the Forum Office (in the Saville Centre, 436 Lewisham High Street near the hospital—again phone in advance to check we are in).
- Tickets will also be sold at the Theatre door @ £3.00 on the day in the usual way.
- There is limited wheelchair access to the Theatre, **but please phone the Forum Office** so that we can confirm access arrangements for you and maybe help with transport.
- People assisting those with mobility difficulties are very welcome, but they do need to buy a ticket if they want a lunch bag.
- Please also note that **large electric scooters DO NOT fit in the lift at the Theatre** nor is there anywhere for them to be stored if transferring in the Theatre Foyer.
- **We will be booking transport for people with mobility issues.** If you would like to take advantage of this then please contact the Forum office on 020 8690 7869. **The deadline for booking a place on the minibus is 12 noon on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> September.**
- **We are earmarking lower stall seats for people who find stairs difficult and we would ask you to respect this when choosing where to sit.**
