

# Human Rights Story Dice

## Introduction:

The human rights story dice game consists of a dice with six prompts and a set of human rights-oriented theme cards. The game can be used for human rights training purposes, in conversations with care workers, people receiving care and their families or by anyone who would like to engage with the topic of human rights in care. To start the game, one person chooses a theme card or chooses a topic to speak about. The person then rolls the dice and tries to speak about the topic using the prompt that is face up on the dice. The dice can be rolled as many times as the person wants to.

## The six dice prompts are:

Hallelujah

Almost Unmentionable

Risking It

Hot Topic

Its Complicated

Recurring Theme.

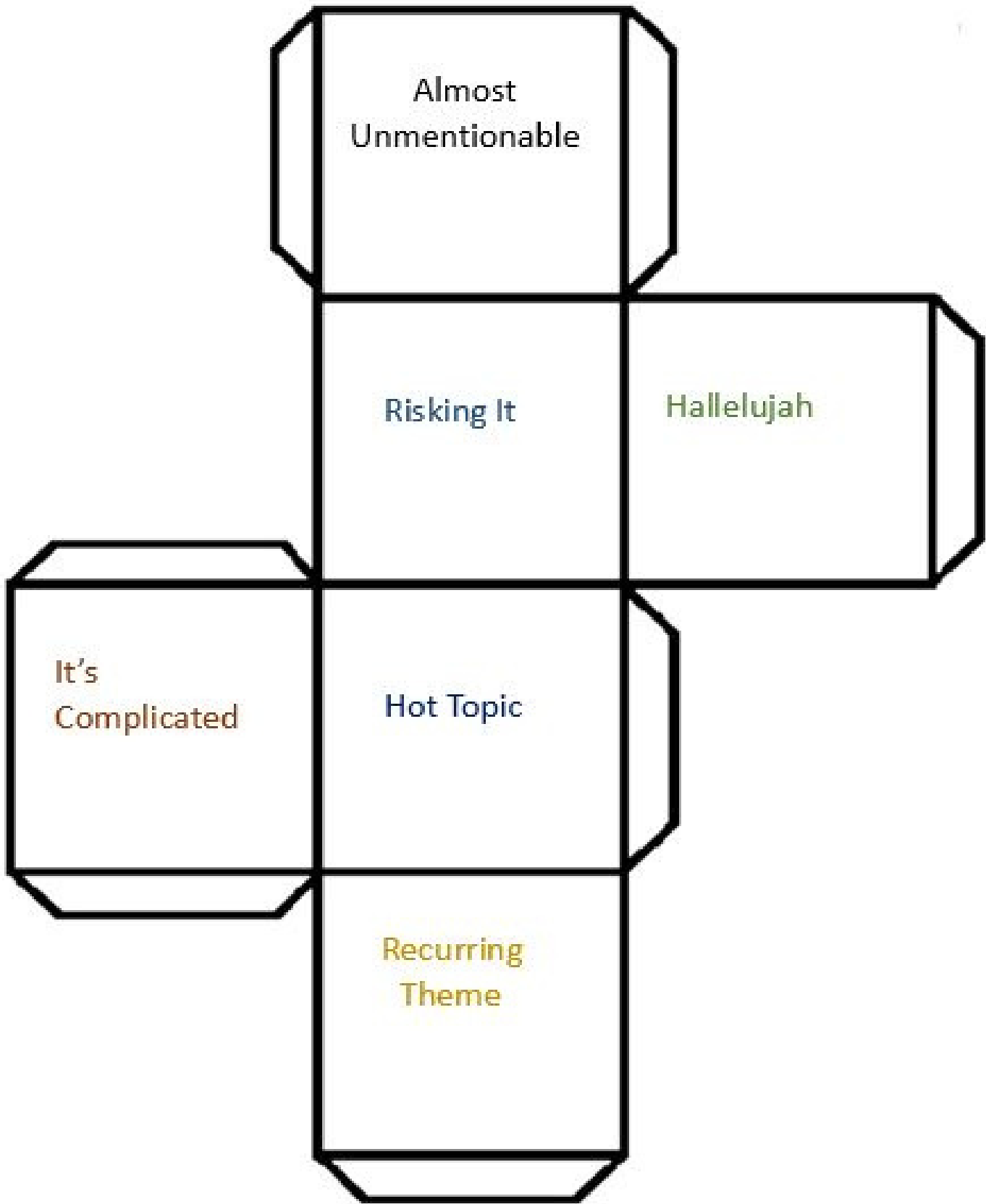
