## **AN ENVIRONMENT OF RESPECT**

LISTEN respectfully to others, encourage diversity in perspectives, and foster continuing discussion AVOID intimidating, dismissive, hostile, or offensive interactions REFRAIN from making comments on dress and appearance CONSTRUCTIVELY challenge inappropriate comments and behaviour when it is safe to do so USE appropriate language and images
