What is the Hong Kong Scholarship?

The Hong Kong Scholarship is sponsored by the King's Alumni Association in Hong Kong. The branch was first formed in 1982 for the benefit of King's alumni living in Hong Kong. It is the aim of the scholarship to provide support to exceptional students at King's with the intention that students will return to Hong Kong after graduation to contribute to Hong Kong interests.

The Hong Kong Scholarship aims to support Hong Kong residents planning to study for any three-year undergraduate course at King's with a scholarship of £15,000 over three years. This prestigious scholarship will be awarded based on academic excellence and personal statement.

Applications are open to both UK and international applicants who are permanently resident in Hong Kong.

How much is the scholarship worth?

In the 2021-22 academic year, one scholarship will be available. The total value of the award is £15,000 (£5,000 per student annually, for three years maximum).

Students undertaking an UG course that is more than 3 years may apply but funding will only be given for 3 years. Study abroad years, intercalated years, interruptions and repeat years are not included with this scholarship. If you are awarded this scholarship, you will be required to submit an annual end of year report until your end of studies and by accepting this award you are agreeing to submit this information. Failure to do so may result in your scholarship being rescinded.

Scholarship recipients may also be invited to meet with members of the Hong Kong Alumni Association and other recipients annually in a private event.

Am I eligible to apply?

- *Permanent Hong Kong resident;*
- *Outstanding academic performance;*
- *Provide a personal statement, including what your plans are post-graduation and how you hope to contribute to Hong Kong interests;*
- *Undertaking a full-time three-year undergraduate programme at King's, starting in Sept 2021. (Students undertaking an UG course that is more than 3 years may apply but funding will only be funded for 3 years).*
- *Have taken up your maximum entitlement to UK government help with tuition fees and loans/grants for living costs, if eligible;*
- *You must have given Student Finance England 'consent' to share your financial information with the College, if eligible;*
- *You should have accepted your offer of a place to study at King's in 2021.*

How do I complete the application form?

Please ensure you answer all questions and complete all sections of the form. The questions on the form are designed to establish your financial and academic circumstances as clearly as possible.

You will need to supply documentary evidence with your application (see checklist below). If these are not supplied, your application will not be considered.

The closing date for applications is 5pm on Monday 5 July 2021.

What should I do with my completed application?

Completed applications and supporting documentation should be sent to funding@kcl.ac.uk

When will I know the outcome of my application?

Provided your application form has been accurately completed and the appropriate documentary evidence supplied, you will be notified of the decision by the end of Aug 2021.

Students who have been successful in their application will receive half the annual award in October 2021, and the second half in February 2022, dependent upon continued satisfactory academic progress and attendance.
