

Money to study

- Amount varies where student lives, studies & household income*
- Based on tax year, 2 years prior to start of academic year
- Assessed annually

in some instances the student may be regarded as independent so parental income ignored e.g.

- care leaver
- estranged from parents
- no living parents






Where does the money go?




