ESDP Eligibility Information

2018 Entry

For 2018 entry, applicants attending all non-selective state schools*, as determined by the UK Government's Department for Education (DfE), are eligible to apply for the ESDP. This means there is no longer a published list of schools to consult.

Applicants must have been attending a non-selective state school since the age of 11, and will need to list all the schools they have attended since the age of 11 on their UCAS application.

Candidates attending Grammar Schools are not eligible to apply for the ESDP, and should apply to the standard Dentistry programme.

Please refer to the *Entry Requirements* and *Course Detail* sections for further information on the requirements and eligibility criteria.

*Non-selective state schools are defined as schools where candidates are not required to complete an entry exam in order to compete for a place at the school.

State schools are funded by the UK Government and do not charge fees. This includes community schools, free schools, and academies.
