*CPE scores are reported on the Cambridge scale from 162 upwards on a Statement of Results. However, a formal certificate is issued only for scores above 180 (CEFR level C1) and then passing Grades A, B, and C. CPE scores can therefore be used for direct entry only on courses which require 180+ on the Cambridge scale. A 176 sub-test score is only accepted with a CAE.

** Direct entry onto these courses is possible with the CPE if the sub-tests scores are also at 180+ on the Cambridge scale.

*** Where IELTS 5.0 is required, only a high-scoring CAE equivalent is accepted because the CAE only tests to the bottom B2 (CEFR). This is reported on the certificate as 160 points on the Cambridge scale.
