King's Scholars of Tomorrow Scholarship 2020

The King's Scholars of Tomorrow is a scholarship award of £2,000 per recipient which can be awarded to up to ten students.

Applicants must hold an offer to study either:

- The King's International Foundation programme
- OR
- The King's Extended International Foundation programme

and be commencing their studies in the autumn term of 2020 – August for those on the extended programme and September for all other students.

The prize of £2,000 is deducted from the total tuition fees for the foundation programme at King's College London. No cash alternative is offered. If a student does not enrol on the Foundation Programme the prize is withdrawn. The scholarship is only available to students on a King's International Foundation or King's Extended International Foundation programme and is not transferable to any other programme of study at King's College London.

Am I eligible for the King's Scholars of Tomorrow scholarship?

To be eligible* to apply for the King's Scholars of Tomorrow scholarship, you must:

- Be eligible to study a King's International Foundation or Extended King's International Foundation programme.
- Meet the entry requirements for your chosen King's International Foundation or King's Extended International Foundation programme.
- Have submitted a completed application to your chosen King's International Foundation or King's Extended International Foundation programme for autumn 2020 entry.
- Be legally allowed to study in the United Kingdom (i.e. not restricted from entering the UK or from applying for a study visa).
- Hold an offer to study at King's by the time the scholarship applications are reviewed.

*Please note that being eligible does not mean an automatic entitlement to a scholarship, as final selection by committee is based upon your video submission.



How do I apply for a King's Scholars of Tomorrow scholarship?

Please upload your one minute video via the [form on the website](#) by **23:59 GMT, Sunday 19 April 2020**.
The file name of your video needs to include your:

1. King's Student Number
2. First name and last name
3. The name of the pathway

Here are some examples showing how to structure your file name:

1812345-Fatima Basri-Liberal Arts and Social Sciences

1809876-Wang Li-Maths and Physics

On the [King's Scholars of Tomorrow platform](#), you will also be asked to fill in your first name, last name and email address before you can upload your video.

NOTE: Please make sure you use the same email address as in your King's International Foundation or Extended King's International Foundation application so we can match your scholarship video submission with your programme application.

What are we looking for in your video?

- A clear and fluent style, demonstrating your English abilities.
- A well-structured argument, showing why you believe your chosen Foundation pathway is the beginning of your future studies at King's and/or your career.



Important information

1. The application deadline is 23.59 GMT, Sunday 19 April 2020.
2. The offer of a scholarship is provisional upon the offer holder accepting and enrolling on a King's International Foundation or Extended King's International Foundation programme by the enrolment deadline in 2020
3. Applicants who have been selected for the scholarship will be informed by 1 May 2020. Please note that only successful applicants will be contacted.
4. Students who interrupt, suspend or cease their studies are not eligible to receive the scholarship and will have the scholarship offer withdrawn.
5. Students may ask permission to defer entry for one year only after which time the offer of a scholarship will be withdrawn.
6. Applications will only be considered if the applicant holds an offer for a Foundation programme at King's College London.

7. The award is not a cash payment to the recipient. The amount is automatically deducted from the total tuition fee for the King's International Foundation or King's Extended International Foundation programme in October 2020.
8. Scholarship recipients agree to King's *Foundations*, King's College London using:
 - a. Their video submissions for promotional purposes
 - b. An image of the recipient in promotional materials.
9. The selection panel will consist of a group of key academics and professional services staff from King's *Foundations*, King's College London. All decisions of the panel are final.
