Top Tip

Student Funding

Find out about the range of funding options available to help you achieve your potential.



Disability Advisory Service

Ask about the wide range of support available for disabled students, including those with long-term medical or mental health conditions or specific learning difficulties, such as dyslexia.



King's Sport

Discover what sports activities and facilities you can take advantage of, whether you're a first time participant, an elite performer or anything in between.



Student Advice

Ask about the wide range of support available to you while studying at King's, from money to immigration and welfare to housing advice.



Modern Language Centre

Find out how to expand your learning by opting to take assessed language modules, or evening language classes.



Global Mobility

Look out for the student ambassadors wearing Study Abroad badges and ask them any questions you may have!

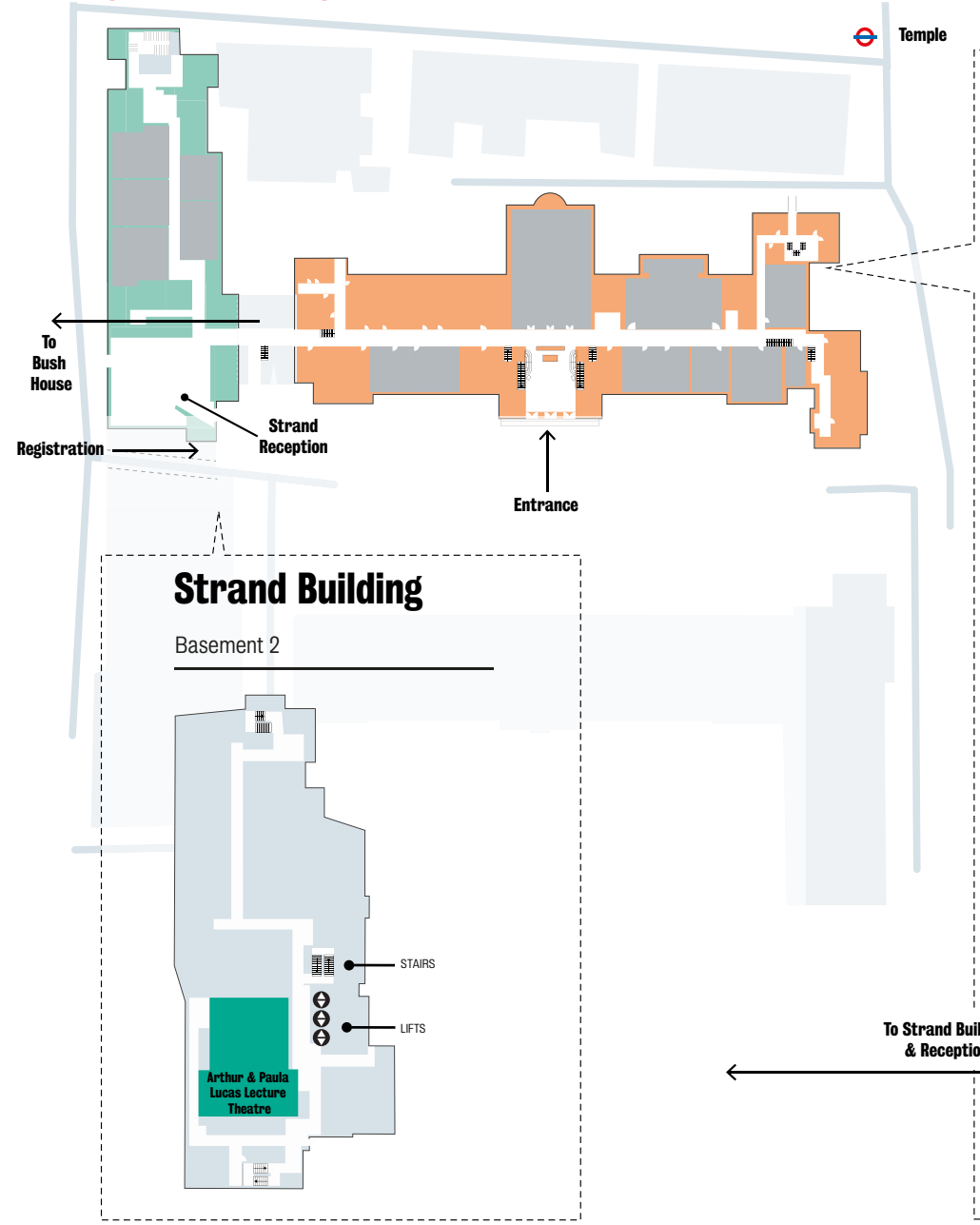

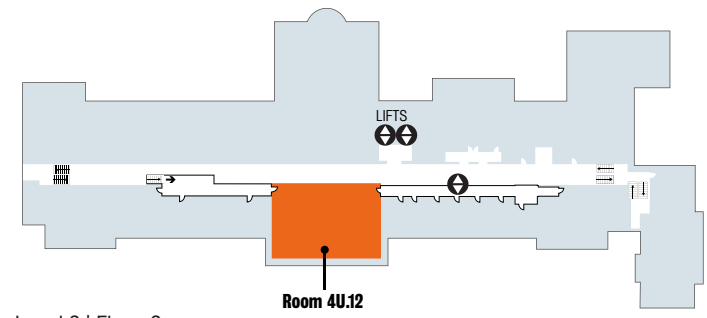

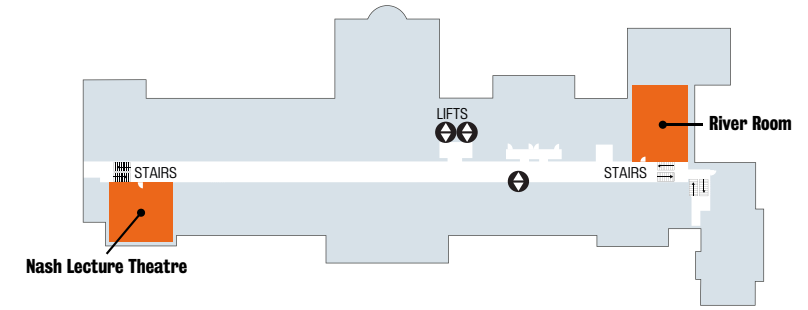


King's Building

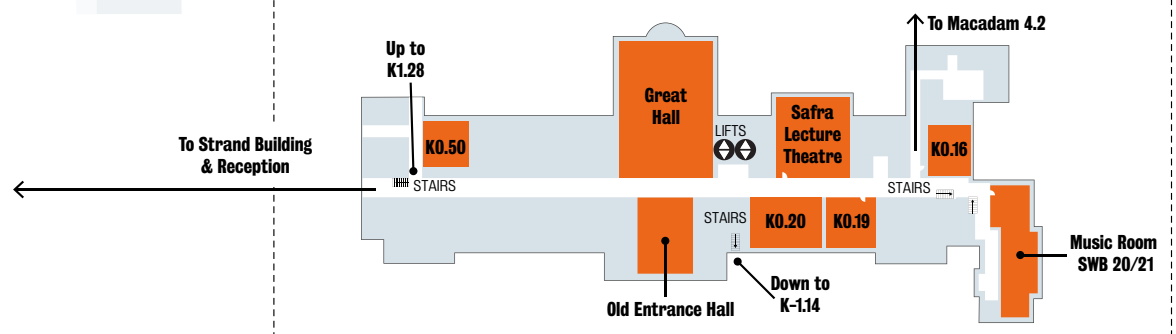
Level 4 | Floor 4



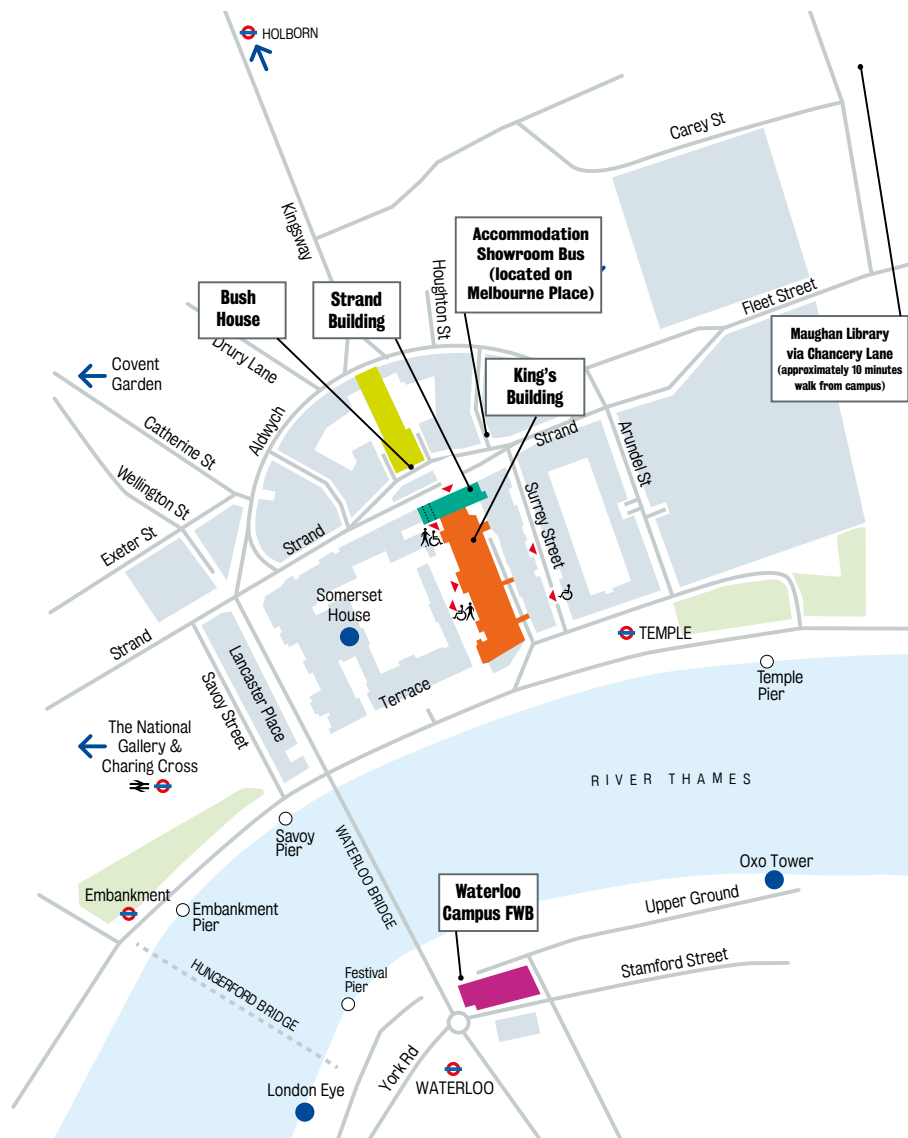
Level 2 | Floor 2
